



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### SITE PREPARATION AND SERVICE RELOCATION, KENSINGTON

**24 JULY - LATE AUGUST 2017**

Works in preparation for major construction on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway across Melbourne. In Kensington, these works include the removal and relocation of high voltage (HV) transmission towers.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works.

#### What we are doing

Before we can begin construction of the western tunnel entrance and other associated works, we need to relocate a number of the existing HV towers located within the rail corridor and on Childers Street, to make way for the new decline structure (see map overleaf).

One of the locations for a new temporary tower is on Childers Street, close to South Kensington station. Prior to relocating the towers, we need to:

- Prepare the site for the installation of a temporary HV transmission tower. This will include erecting temporary fencing, removing excess soil to level the site and constructing a hardstand to support the crane which will be used to install the new tower
- Divert an existing drainage pipe in the vicinity of the temporary tower and protect an existing watermain to allow for loading of the crane and piling rig.

#### What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work site to ensure the safety of the community and work crews
- There will be medium level noise associated with this activity
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- There will be temporary diversions in place for pedestrians and cyclists
- We will need to occupy approximately 16 parking spaces on Childers Street at the works location
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

#### When

From Monday 24 July, until late August 2017

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

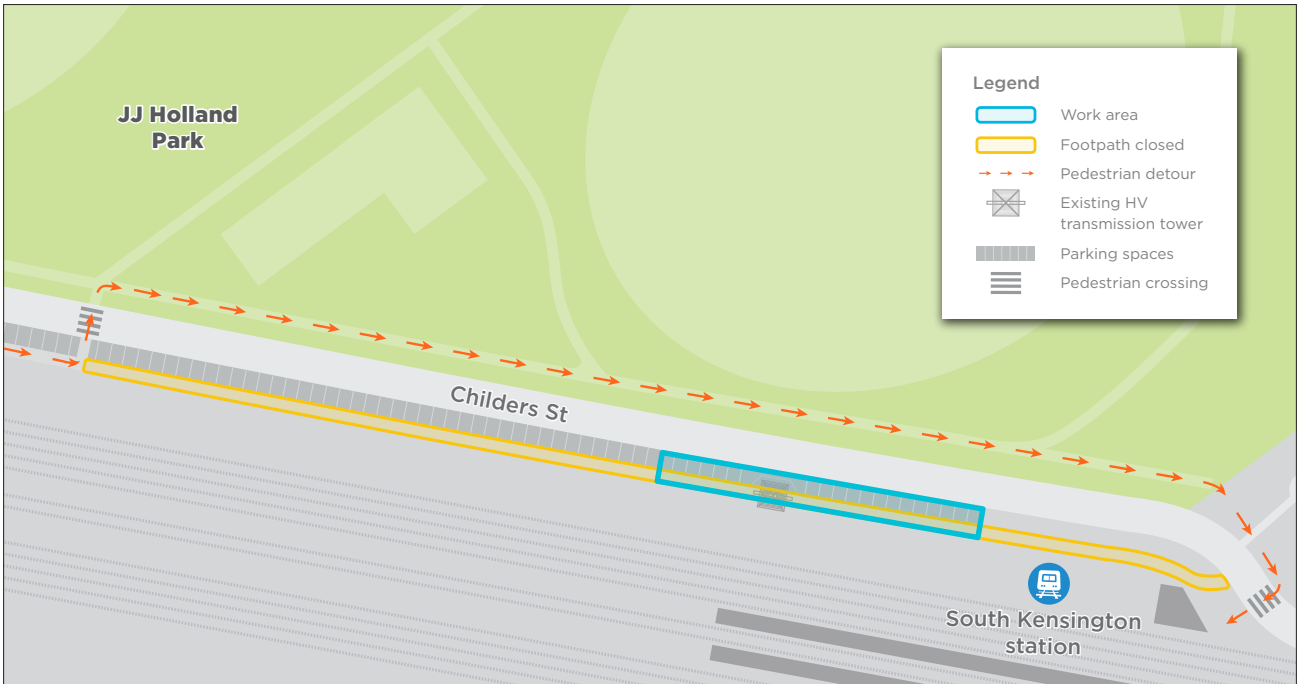
All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.
