

## Station Naming Competition

### Terms and Conditions of Entry

#### *How to Enter*

1. Information on how to enter the Station Naming Competition forms part of these terms and conditions of entry. Participation in this Station Naming Competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry. Entries must comply with these terms and conditions to be valid.
2. The Promoter will conduct six separate promotions, with separate prize pools, as follows:
  - a. one promotion for school students under 18 years (the **Student Competition**); and
  - b. five promotions for persons who are 18 years and over, or persons who are under 18 years but are not school students (the five **Open Competitions**), (together the **Competitions**) as set out in these terms and conditions.
3. The Competitions commence at 12.01am AEST on Sunday 27 August 2017 and close at 11:59pm AEST on Sunday 22 October 2017 (**Promotional Period**).
4. The Promoter of the Competitions is Melbourne Metro Rail Authority – an administrative office in relation to the Department of Economic Development Jobs Transport and Resources (ABN 69 981 208 782) (**Promoter**) of Level 13, 121 Exhibition St, Melbourne, VIC, 3000.
5. Officers, employees and immediate families of officers and employees of the Promoter, and the associated companies, agencies and contractors of the Promoter are ineligible to enter the Competitions.
6. The Student Competition is open to Victorian school students under 18 years.
7. The Open Competitions are open to persons who are 18 years and over, or who are under 18 years and are not school students, who are residents of Victoria.
8. A limit of one entry per person per competition applies.
9. By submitting an entry, entrants acknowledge and agree they may be required by the Promoter to participate in photo or video recordings including as part of the site tours awarded as prizes and the public announcement(s) of the Metro Tunnel station name(s), as set out in these terms and conditions.
10. There is no entry fee for the Competitions.
11. Entries can be submitted to the Promoter in three ways. Eligible entrants can enter:
  - a. online at [www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations](http://www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations) during the Promotional Period by completing the online entry form; or

- b. in-person at the Melbourne Writers Festival (**MWF**) during 27 August 2017 to 3 September 2017 by completing an entry card and placing it in a secure box at MWF; or
- c. in-person at various public sites during the Promotional Period by completing an entry card and returning it to the Promoter during the Promotional Period.

### *Eligible Entries*

12. This is a game of chance.
13. To enter the Competitions, entrants must submit a valid entry to the Promoter during the Promotion Period which nominates a name for one or more of the five proposed new Metro Tunnel stations. To be a valid entry, the selected new Metro Tunnel station name must comply with the naming rules for places in Victoria (**Naming Rules**) located at <https://www.propertyandlandtitles.vic.gov.au/naming-places-features-and-roads/naming-rules-for-places-in-victoria>.
14. If an eligible entrant, as part of a valid entry in the Student Competition, has nominated a name for a new Metro Tunnel Station which matches the name ultimately selected by the Victorian Government to be the approved name for that new Metro Tunnel Station, that entry will be a **Correct Student Entry**. All Correct Student Entries will go into the draw for the Student Competition. For the avoidance of doubt, only one Correct Student Entry per entrant will be included in the draw for the Student Competition, even if that Correct Entry nominates more than one name ultimately selected.
15. If an eligible entrant, as part of a valid entry in one of the Open Competitions, nominates a name for one of the new Metro Tunnel Station which matches the name ultimately selected by the Victorian Government to be the approved name for that new Metro Tunnel Station, that entry will be a **Correct Open Entry**. All Correct Open Entries in respect of a particular Metro Tunnel Station will go into the draw for the Open Competition for that Metro Tunnel Station. There are five Open Competitions in total corresponding to each new Metro Tunnel Station. For the avoidance of doubt, if an eligible entrant nominates a correct name for more than one Metro Tunnel Station, that entrant will go into the draw for each of the Open Competitions corresponding to that Metro Tunnel Station.
16. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries, prize claims and entrants (including an entrant's identity, state of residence, school or age). The Promoter may disqualify any entrant who submits an entry or prize claim that is not a Valid Entry or is otherwise not in accordance with these terms and conditions, or who tampers with the entry process. An entry that is incomplete, indecipherable, illegible, contains explicit or otherwise offensive language or is non-compliant with these terms and conditions is invalid and will not be accepted or considered. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

### *Student Competition*

17. The draw for the Student Competition will take place at 11am AEST on the third business day after the Victorian Government advises the Promoter of its decision regarding the new Metro Tunnel station names (**Prize Draw Date**) at the Promoter's premises at Level 13, 121 Exhibition St, Melbourne, VIC, 3000.
18. The first Correct Student Entry drawn will be the winner of the prize for the Student Competition. The draw will be by random ballot. Winning is not contingent upon being present at the draw. The Promoter will make reasonable efforts to identify and contact the prize winner.
19. The prize for the Student Competition consists of one site tour to one of the Metro Tunnel Precincts (Arden, CBD North, CBD South, Domain and Parkville) for members of the winner's school class (up to a maximum of 25 participants in total). The total prize pool for the Student Competition is one site tour.
20. The site tour will run for approximately two (2) hours on a date within 24 months of the draw to be agreed between the Promoter and the winner.
21. The winner of the Student Competition will be notified by letter to their school within 28 days after the Prize Draw Date (**Notification Period**).
22. To accept the prize, the Student Competition winner and/or their parent or legal guardian (as required by the Promoter) must:
  - a. Sign a release form provided by the Promoter:
    - (i) confirming acceptance of these terms and conditions;
    - (ii) in the case of parents/guardians, accepting full responsibility for the winner in respect of the prize;
    - (iii) allowing the first name and school of the winner to be published on the Promoter's website and affiliate websites and social media channels; and
    - (iv) allowing the winner to be filmed and photographed at the announcement of the Metro Tunnel Names (if present) and during the site tours for the Promoter's marketing and communications purposes and for use on the Promoter's website, affiliate websites and social media channels, and
  - b. obtain and provide consent in the form provided by the Promoter from a representative of the school to participate in the prize and a release allowing (iii) and (iv) above.
23. If the winner of the Student Competition does not provide written acceptance of the prize and the documents required in paragraph 22 within two weeks after the end of the Notification Period the prize will be forfeited and the Promoter may draw another winner for the prize.

24. The first name and school of the Student Competition winner will be published on the Promoter's website at [www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations](http://www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations) following acceptance of the prize and the public announcement of the Metro Tunnel Station names.
25. The prize is subject to any written conditions provided with the prize.
26. If the prize is unavailable due to circumstances outside the Promoter's control (including if the winner is no longer attending school in Victoria), a substitute prize of the same or greater value will be offered to the winner in writing.

### *Open Competitions*

27. The draws for each of the Open Competitions will take place at 11.10am AEST on the third business day after the Victorian Government advises the Promoter of its decision regarding the new Metro Tunnel station names (**Prize Draw Date**) at the Promoter's premises at Level 13, 121 Exhibition St, Melbourne, VIC, 3000.
28. The first Correct Open Entry drawn for each of the five Open Competitions will be the winners of the prizes for the Open Competitions. The draw will be by random ballot. Winning is not contingent upon being present at the draw. The Promoter will make reasonable efforts to identify and contact the prize winners.
29. The prize for each Open Competition consists of one site tour to one of the Metro Tunnel Precincts (Arden, CBD North, CBD South, Domain and Parkville) for the winner and up to five family members or friends. The total prize pool for each Open Competition is one site tour.
30. The site tours will run for approximately two (2) hours on a date within 24 months of the draw to be agreed between the Promoter and each winner.
31. The winners of the Open Competitions will be notified by email to the email address nominated in their entry within 28 days after the Prize Draw Date (**Notification Period**).
32. To accept the prize, each Open Competition winner (or their parent or legal guardian if applicable) must sign a release form provided by the Promoter:
  - a. confirming acceptance of these terms and conditions;
  - b. in the case of parents/guardians, accepting full responsibility for the winner in respect of the prize;
  - c. allowing the full name of the winner to be published on the Promoter's website, affiliate websites and social media channels; and
  - d. allowing the winner to be filmed and photographed at the announcement of the Metro Tunnel Names (if present) and during the site tours for the Promoter's marketing and communications purposes and for use on the Promoter's website, affiliate websites and social media channels.

33. If a winner of one of the Open Competitions does not provide written acceptance of the prize and the documents required in paragraph 32 within two weeks after the end of the Notification Period the prize will be forfeited and the Promoter may draw another winner for the prize.
34. The full name of the Open Competition winners will be published on the Promoter's website at [www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations](http://www.metrotunnel.vic.gov.au/stations) following acceptance of the prize and the public announcement of the Metro Tunnel Station names.
35. Each prize is subject to any written conditions provided with the prize.
36. If the prize is unavailable due to circumstances outside the Promoter's control, a substitute prize of the same or greater value will be offered to the winner in writing.

#### *Substitute Draw*

37. If the Promoter has been unable to identify the winner of a prize, or a prize has been forfeited because the prize winner has not provided written acceptance of the prize during the Notification Period, the Promoter may conduct a substitute draw on the date which is 14 days after the end of the Notification Period at the same place as the original draw

#### *General Conditions*

38. During the entire duration of any site tour conducted as part of a prize, a responsible adult must accompany any person under the 18 years of age.
39. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries or other communications.
40. All entries become and remain the property of the Crown in the right of the State of Victoria upon submission. By entering a Competition eligible entrants assign to the State of Victoria all rights, including intellectual property rights, in the entry including suggested station names. Entrants acknowledge that the State of Victoria owns all rights in entries submitted to the Promoter, including station names. Entrants consent to the Promoter dealing with an entrant's entry in any way (including copying, modifying, adapting, publishing, or communicating the entry) which may otherwise infringe the moral rights of the entrant.
41. Personal information is collected, used and disclosed by the Promoter for purposes including administering the Competitions, complying with applicable laws (such as laws relating to running competitions) and announcing and contacting winners. The information may be disclosed to third parties who are assisting in administering the Competitions, supplying prizes and otherwise as set out in these terms and conditions or permitted by law. 42. If a Competition is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Competition to the full extent permitted by law and subject to any approval or directions from a regulatory authority.
43. Nothing in these terms and conditions is intended to exclude, restrict or modify any right which an entrant may have under law (including the Australian Consumer Law), and any consumer guarantee relating to goods or services under the Australian Consumer Law which may not be excluded, restricted or modified by agreement (Your Consumer Rights). Subject to Your Consumer Rights, the promoter is not liable for any loss or damage which is or may be suffered or sustained as a direct or indirect result of an entrant entering or participating in the Competition or winning or failing to win a prize, or using or permitting any other person to use the prize, except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law or that would cause any part of this clause to be void or unenforceable.
44. This promotion is governed by the law of Victoria, Australia.
