



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### SERVICE RELOCATION, PARKVILLE 4 MAY 2017 TO MID-JULY

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes site establishment, tree and vegetation removal, and the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

#### What we are doing

##### Service investigations

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on Royal Parade, near Grattan Street
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service.

##### Service relocation

- Installing a new sewer main under Royal Parade. These works will be carried out using a surface launched drilling rig to bore a path beneath the surface between an entry and exit point using excavators and cranes
- Installing new power cables under Elizabeth Street by bore between an entry and exit point

- Installing new power cables along the east side of Elizabeth Street between Grattan Street and Haymarket Walk and the west side of Elizabeth street for 20 metres north of Haymarket roundabout. These works will be carried out by open cut trenching, consisting of excavating a trench and manually installing each piece of pipe, backfilling and reinstating the area
- Building pits within University of Melbourne land near Grattan Street.

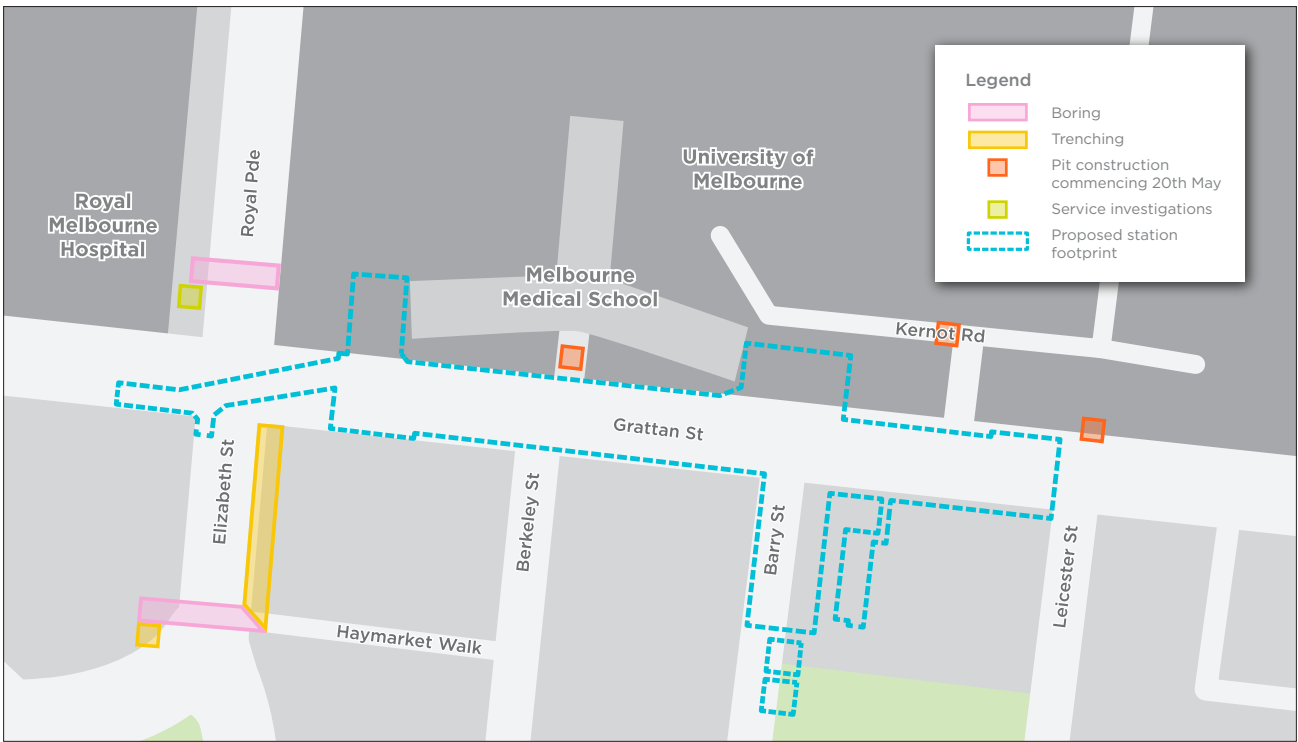
#### What to be aware of

- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic. Please refer to signage in the area
- We will need to temporarily occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Royal Parade and Elizabeth Street as the works progress
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There may be some temporary pedestrian and cyclist diversions
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday

### Service relocation

- From Monday 8 May, until mid-July 2017
- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.
