



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### SERVICE INVESTIGATIONS, ARDEN 15 MAY TO 24 MAY 2017

As you may be aware, works for the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway with activities taking place ahead of the start of major construction.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works, which includes service relocation, tree and vegetation removal and demolition of existing buildings within the Arden Station construction site. This area is bounded by Laurens Street, Barwise Street, Moonee Ponds Creek and the Upfield rail lines.

#### What we are doing

##### Service investigations

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on Laurens Street
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service (including in footpaths and roads).

##### What to be aware of

- Laurens Street will remain open to traffic
- Traffic management measures will be in place on Laurens Street to allow one lane of traffic through at a time
- We may need to temporarily occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Laurens Street at the works location

- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There may be some temporary pedestrian diversions
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

#### When

- Monday 15 May to Wednesday 24 May 2017
- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions
- We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

#### Keeping the community informed

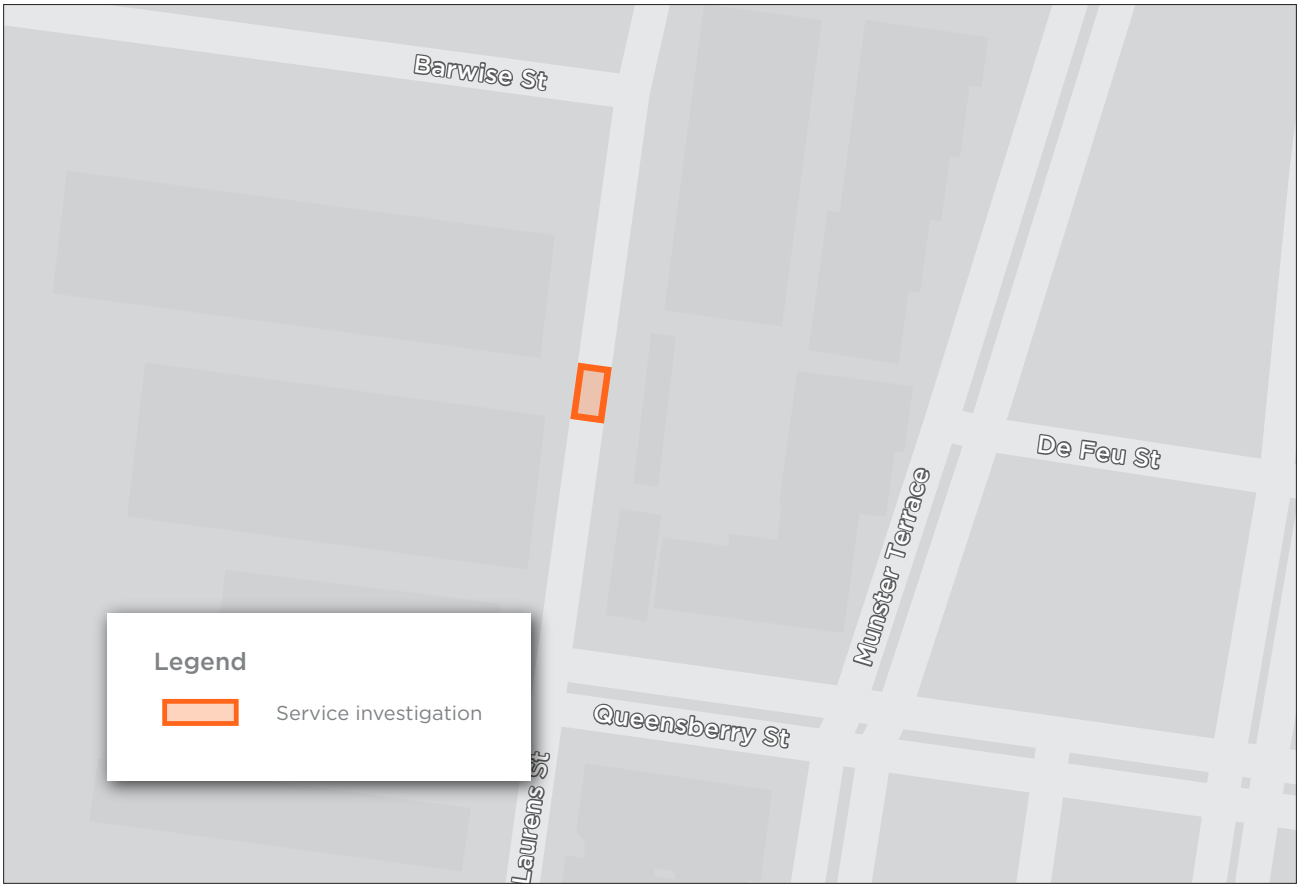
John Holland understands that there will be some unavoidable impacts from these works, and is committed to keeping the community and stakeholders informed of all works and any expected impacts, before they occur.
