



HOBSONS ROAD SITE ESTABLISHMENT, KENSINGTON FROM 7 JUNE, UNTIL EARLY AUGUST 2017

Works in preparation for major construction on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works, which include the relocation of high voltage (HV) transmission towers along Childers Street, and some tree and vegetation removal.

What we are doing

We are establishing a temporary construction laydown and support site on Hobsons Road (corner of Hobsons and Kensington roads) to facilitate construction of the western tunnel entrance in Kensington. This site will be used by John Holland to support relocation of the HV towers, and also by other contractors appointed to build the tunnel and tunnel entrance.

- Preparing the Hobsons Road site for the installation of a HV transmission tower. This will include erecting temporary fencing, removing excess soil to level the site and constructing a temporary access point (driveway) into the site
- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services within the site.

When

- From Wednesday, 7 June to early August 2017
- 7am 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am 1pm, Saturdays
- All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions
- We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work site to ensure the safety of the community and work crews
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- There may be some temporary pedestrian path diversions
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.

Keeping the community informed

John Holland understands that there will be some unavoidable impacts from these works, and is committed to keeping the community and stakeholders informed of all works and any expected impacts, before they occur.


