



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SITE PREPARATION AND SERVICE INVESTIGATION, KENSINGTON

4 JULY - EARLY AUGUST 2017

Works in preparation for major construction on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway across Melbourne. In Kensington, these works include the removal and relocation of high voltage (HV) transmission towers along Childers Street.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works.

What we are doing

Service investigation

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on Childers Street, beside the current HV transmission tower
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service (including in footpaths and roads).

Site preparation

- Vegetation removal and pruning of the spotted gum tree will take place on Childers Street, near South Kensington station. This activity will prepare the site for the installation of the temporary HV transmission tower. Chainsaws, excavators and boom lifts will be used.

What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work site to ensure the safety of the community and work crews
- There will be some noise associated with this activity, particularly during NDD and saw-cutting
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- There may be some temporary pedestrian path diversions
- We will need to occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Childers Street
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all time.

When

From Tuesday 4 July to early August 2017

- 7am - 6pm, Tuesday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

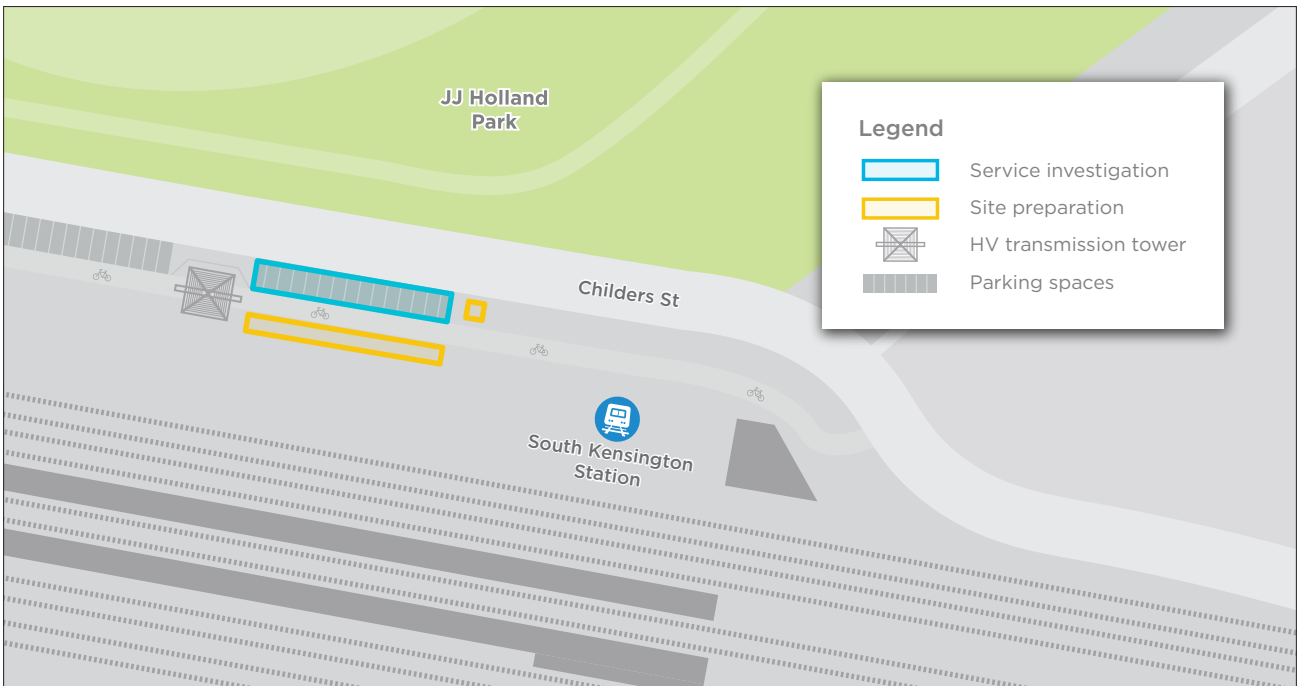
All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.
