



WORKS NOTIFICATION

NIGHT WORKS FOR WATER MAIN TRUNCATION, WILLIAM STREET, SOUTH YARRA 16 - 17 MAY 2017

Works in preparation for major construction of the Metro Tunnel are about to start in the Eastern Portal precinct.

This will include the relocation of water, gas, power and telecommunication utility services in this precinct with service investigations having been completed late last year.

What we are doing

On Tuesday 16 May and Wednesday 17 May 2017 night works will be required to truncate the water main in William Street, South Yarra, on either side of the William Street bridge. This work is required to remove services located on the bridge ahead of main works.

- Open-cut trenching in two sections of William Street (either side of the bridge) to expose and truncate the water main by installing stop valves, making a small section on the bridge redundant
- Saw-cutting the road pavement in the vicinity of the water main and the single property connection point that will be re-run
- Excavating the trench to the required depth and using an excavator and truck to remove material from the site
- Using a saw to cut the required sections of the water main and cap it on either side of the bridge and installing stop valves

- Re-running the single property connection from the impacted section of the water main by laying a new property connection
- Reinstating the road using an excavator to backfill the trench with crushed rock
- Compacting the area and re-asphalting the road.

When

- 7.30pm - 6am, Tuesday 16 and Wednesday 17 May

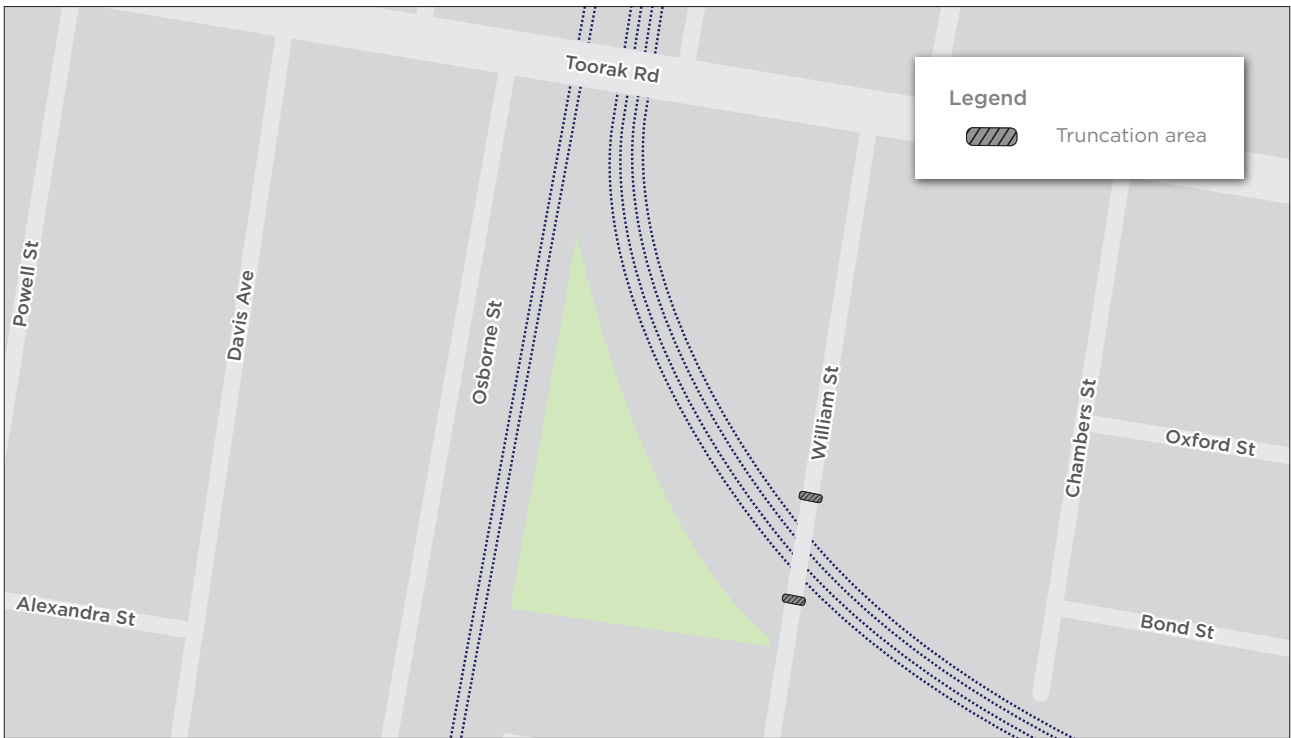
What to be aware of

- South East Water will notify the affected customer ahead of any service outage and the work will be done at night to minimise customer impacts
- There will be periods of medium to high level noise associated with open-cut trenching, saw-cutting and reinstating the impacted area
- Impacts from noise will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements
- Excavation of the trench across William Street will be done in two stages, with traffic management in place to minimise impacts
- A number of car parking spaces on William Street will be temporarily occupied for the duration of these works
- The work site will be reinstated at the conclusion of works.
