



WORKS NOTIFICATION

GAS SERVICE RELOCATION, OSBORNE STREET 17 OCTOBER - LATE DECEMBER 2017

Works in preparation for major construction of the Metro Tunnel are continuing in South Yarra with the relocation of utility services underway and service investigations continuing ahead of upcoming works.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for these works, including the relocation of a section of the gas distribution service in Osborne Street, South Yarra.

What we are doing

Installation works

Installing a new section of gas distribution service and a new gas regulator pit in Osborne Street between Toorak Road and Fawkner Street.

Gas distribution service installation works will involve:

- Open cut trenching, consisting of saw cutting the road, excavating the trench and removing material
- Installing the new service, backfilling and reinstating the area.

Pit installation works will involve:

- Excavating a trench
- Using a crane to lift a pre-cast pit into place and reinstating the area.

Commissioning and decommissioning works

Commissioning works will involve:

- Tying in the new service to the existing service
- Pushing an inert gas through the newly installed section of service to clear the pipes of air using a controlled visible flame through a vent connected to the service.

Decommissioning works will involve:

- Filling the abandoned service with concrete
- Removing the redundant pit using a crane
- Backfilling and reinstating the areas.

What to be aware of

- There will be periods of medium-high level noise associated with saw cutting, open cut trenching and reinstating the road pavement
- A site compound will be established using temporary fencing occupying approximately eight kerbside carparks for the duration of works. This compound is required to store materials and machinery
- We may need to remove up to four trees, however are working hard to reduce this number. All necessary approvals and permits will be in place ahead of works
- There will be no impact to essential services
- All work areas will be temporarily reinstated progressively with permanent reinstatement to be completed at the end of work to ensure a high quality reinstatement.

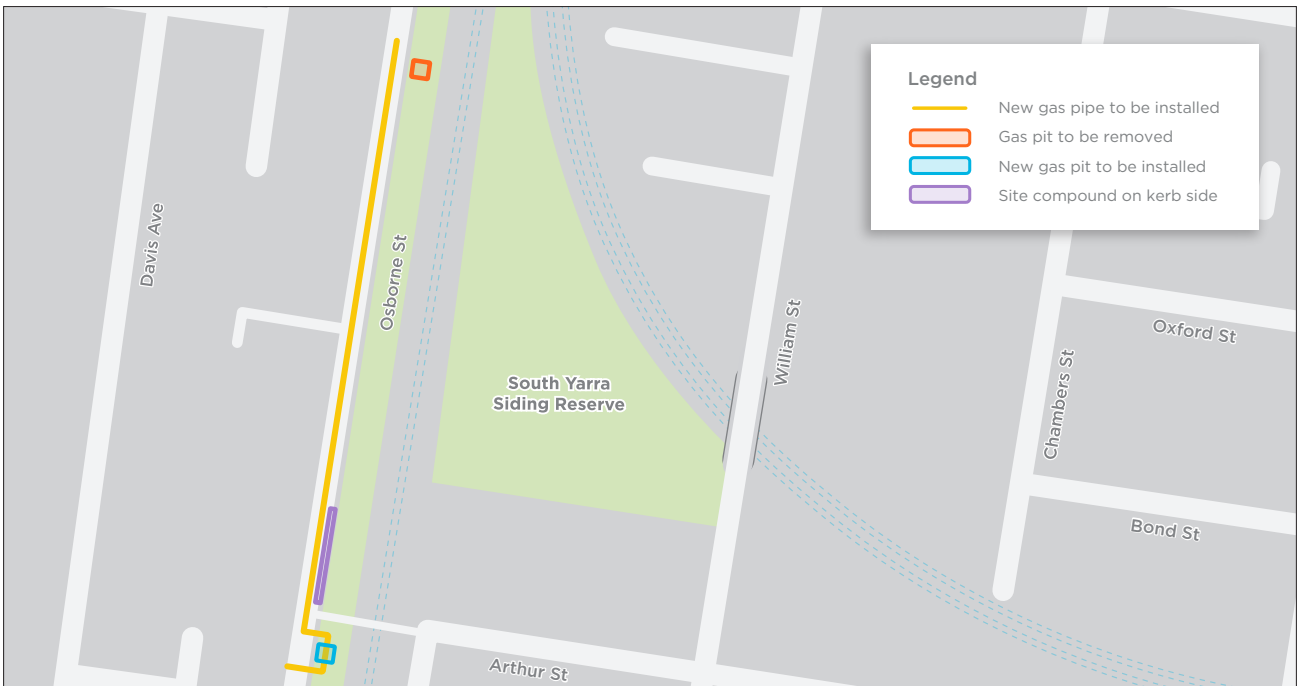
Traffic impacts

- The temporary occupation of kerbside carparks on the east and west sides of Osborne Street will be required to allow for vehicle traffic access
- Traffic management will be in place around each work site to manage the safety of pedestrians, vehicles and cyclists
- There may be short-term road closures during works. Please follow detour signage in place during these periods.
