



WORKS NOTIFICATION

ENHANCING THE ROAD NETWORK - LA TROBE STREET 16 JANUARY 2017

Ahead of major construction for the Metro Tunnel project, changes to the road, tram and bicycle networks are required to keep Melbourne moving during construction.

John Holland is managing the delivery of these works, which will commence from Monday 16 January 2017.

Changes to Latrobe Street

In preparation for the upcoming closure of Franklin and A'Beckett streets, changes will be made to La Trobe Street to allow traffic to flow more efficiently through the city.

What the works will involve

- Removal of parallel parking bays at intersections along La Trobe Street between King Street and Exhibition Street
- Changes to kerbs and footpaths at intersections
- Line marking to identify the new design of the road way
- Changes to traffic signage along La Trobe Street
- Construction of three new accessible parking bays between Swanston Street and Russell Street, including kerb ramp and pavement improvements
- Upgrades to traffic signalling timing.

What to be aware of

- There will be short-term, temporary changes to vehicle and bicycle access. Variable Message Signs (VMS) boards will be in place to provide clear direction

- Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of work crews and pedestrians and maintain traffic flow.

When

- Works will start from Monday 16 January 2017
- 7am – 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am – 1pm, Saturdays
- Night work will be required for permanent line marking along La Trobe Street. This work is expected to take place in late January 2017. We will notify you in advance of these works occurring.

Keeping the community informed

John Holland understands that there will be some unavoidable impacts from these works, and is committed to keeping the community and stakeholders informed of all works and any expected impacts, before they occur.

A dedicated Metro Tunnel Project Information Line (1800 551 927) has been established for construction queries and is monitored by the team during business hours and after hours when works are taking place.
