# SITE ESTABLISHMENT & SERVICE RELOCATION, PARKVILLE 23 MARCH 2017 - MID-MAY

As you may be aware, works for the Metro Tunnel project are now underway with some minor activities taking place ahead of the start of major construction.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes site establishment, tree and vegetation removal, and the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

### What we are doing

#### Site establishment

Tree and vegetation removal will take place within University of Melbourne land along Grattan Street and on the corner of Grattan Street and Royal Parade. Removal will be completed in stages to prepare sites as they are required. Chainsaws, excavators and boom lifts may be used. Further tree removal will be required during the next phase of work.

#### Service relocations

Following site establishment, installation of the drainage, water and sewer mains will commence. These services will be installed by open cut trenching, consisting of excavating a trench and manually installing each piece of pipe, backfilling and reinstating the area.

### What to be aware of

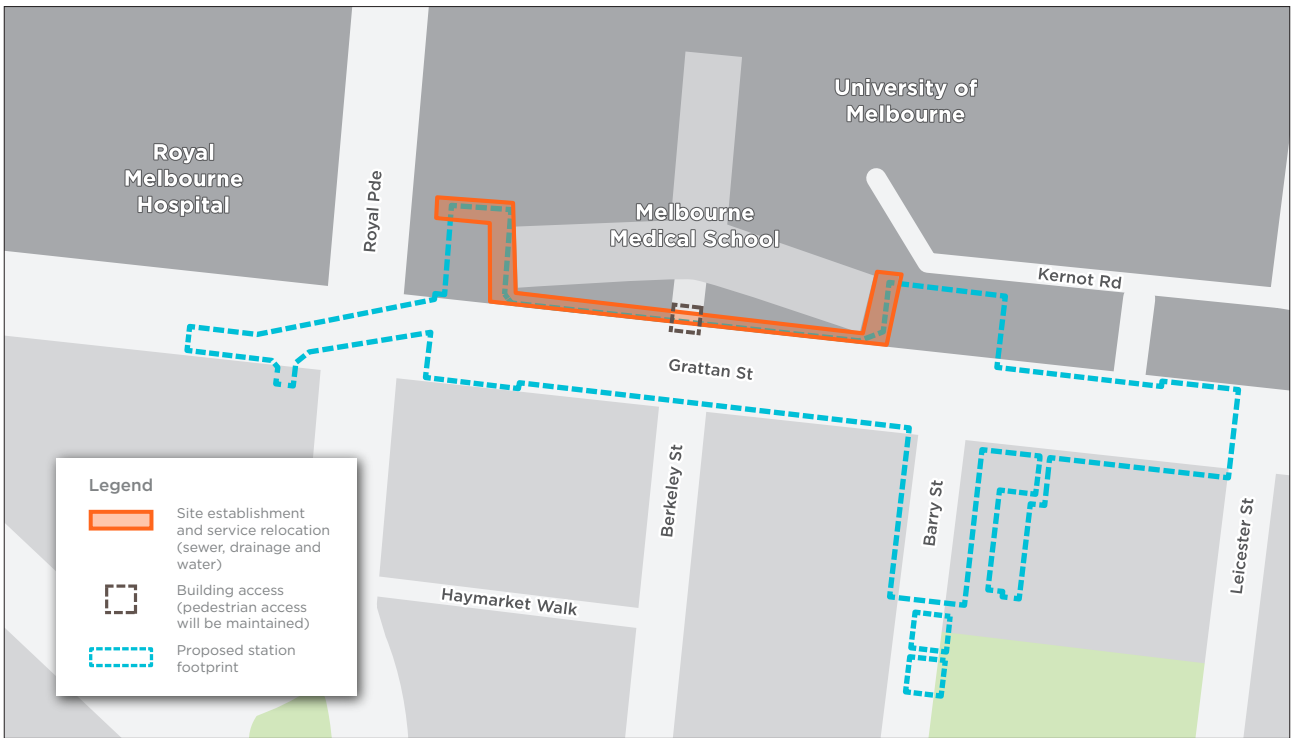
- An eastbound lane closure will be in place on Grattan Street during tree removal between Royal Parade and Barry Street on Saturday 25 March to Sunday 26 March

- An additional weekend closure will be required and we will provide notification prior
- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There will be some temporary pedestrian diversions required
- We will need to occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Grattan Street as the works progress
- Fauna associated with trees to be removed will be assessed and managed appropriately
- Melbourne Metro Rail Authority will replant at least two trees for every tree removed for construction of the Metro Tunnel to enhance long term canopy cover across the Metro Tunnel project
- These works (known as 'enabling works') have been granted the relevant planning approvals to proceed.

### Day works

- From Thursday 23 March 2017, to mid-May
- 7am – 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am – 1pm, Saturday

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

### Out of hours works

- 6pm Friday 24 March to 6pm Saturday 25 March 2017
- 8am Sunday 26 March to 7am Monday 27 March

The footpath on the northern side of Grattan Street, between Royal Parade and the entrance to University of Melbourne (Melbourne Medical School) will be closed during this time. Pedestrian detours will be in place.
