CITY SQUARE AND BUILDING DEMOLITION WORKS UPDATE, CBD SOUTH LATE NOVEMBER 2017 TO JANUARY 2018

Work at City Square and Swanston Street is continuing to prepare for the construction of the new underground station with connections to Flinders Street Station.

What we are doing

City Square car park demolition

From late November, major work to demolish the rest of the existing City Square car park will begin.

Excavators will be used to demolish the three levels of the underground car park structure in preparation for the construction of an access shaft.

Flinders Lane closures between Russell Street and Swanston Street

To complete the demolition, a number of daytime closures of Flinders Lane are required for trucks to deliver equipment and remove debris from the site.

Flinders Lane will be closed between **7am and 6pm** on the following days:

- Monday 27 November 2017 (equipment delivery)
- Saturday 2 December 2017 (equipment delivery)
- Saturday 9 December 2017 (debris removal)
- Saturday 16 December 2017 (debris removal)
- Wednesday 10 January to Saturday 13 January 2018 (debris removal)
- Tuesday 30 January to Saturday 10 February 2018 (debris removal).

What to be aware of

- Traffic will be detoured via Russell Street, Collins Street and Elizabeth Street
- Two-way vehicle access for local residents and businesses will be maintained via traffic controllers between Russell Street and Swanston Street and between Swanston Street and Elizabeth Street
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Various machines will be used during these works, including excavators with hydraulic hammers and pulverisers
- Up to 10 truck movements per hour will be required to remove debris from the City Square site. Trucks will enter the site via Flinders Lane and exit via Flinders Lane and Swanston Street to Flinders Street
- A high level of noise is expected during these works, including the hammering and pulverising to demolish the concrete car park structure.
- Dust will be managed with water sprays, scaffolding, timber hoarding and cloth protection.

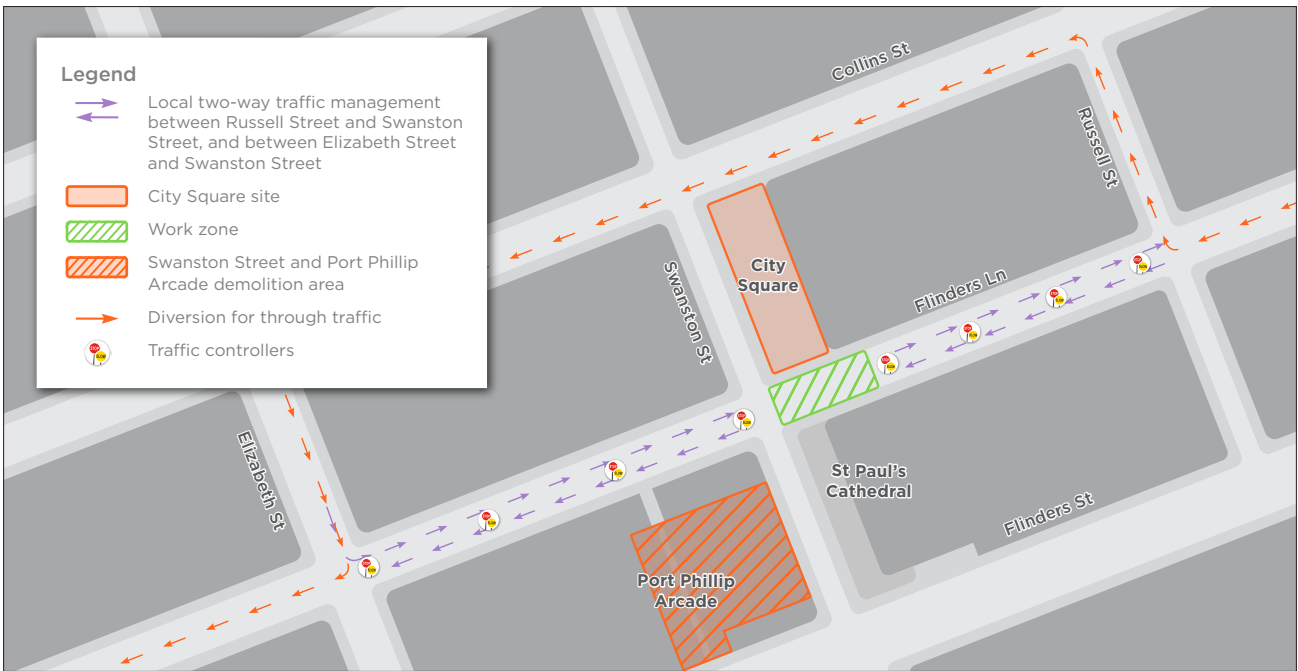
Works at City Square will be occurring during the following hours:

- 7am - 3pm, Saturdays.

Swanston Street and Port Phillip Arcade Building Demolition

Demolition of the buildings between Young and Jackson and the Nicholas Building is ongoing.

Port Phillip Arcade demolition works have commenced with asbestos removal. Licensed asbestos contractors have been engaged to ensure the safe removal of any potential asbestos and maintain the safety of pedestrians, employees and the surrounding area.

CitiPower have also started decommissioning the substation within the basement of Port Phillip Arcade.

Demolition of the main structure will take place from late January 2018.

What to be aware of

- Various tools and machinery, including hydraulic hammers, are being used to dismantle the buildings down to ground level
- Up to 12 truck movements per day are required to remove debris from the site
- Trucks are travelling in and out of the site using Swanston Street
- Public Attendants are stationed along Swanston Street to assist pedestrians to move safely around the site
- Dust is managed onsite with water sprays, scaffolding, timber hoarding and cloth protection.

When

Building demolition works will be occurring during the following hours:

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 3pm, Saturdays.
