



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SOUTH AFRICAN SOLDIERS MEMORIAL REMOVAL 21 AUGUST – NOVEMBER

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway in Domain to support construction of a new underground station.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works.

As the relevant permit from Heritage Victoria has now been received, the removal and storage of the South African Soldiers Memorial and John Cockbill Memorial Drinking Fountain will now commence.

These works will be undertaken over approximately three months, in a number of stages to ensure we provide maximum protection to the memorial during both its removal and storage. The South African Soldiers Memorial will be restored while in storage, before its return to the Albert Road Reserve after the completion of the construction of the new underground station at Domain, in line with permit conditions.

What we are doing

Site establishment

- Erecting temporary fencing around the memorial adjacent to the South Yarra Main Sewer site in the Albert Road Reserve
- Installing heritage interpretation information on the fencing in line with Heritage Victoria Permit requirements

- Removing three angle car parks adjacent to the reserve on the northern leg of Albert Road to provide an access point into the site
- Trimming a number of trees to enable safe operation of the crane and facilitate the removal of the monument, which will occur in sections
- Installing site amenities
- Constructing a stable platform from which the crane will operate
- Setting up the crane
- Erecting scaffolding around the memorial to undertake inspection activities
- Dismantling each section of the memorial using the crane and safely removing these and carefully placing them onto a truck for removal and storage
- Removing the pavers, lions, obelisk and drinking fountain
- Storing the memorial for conservator access and maintenance.

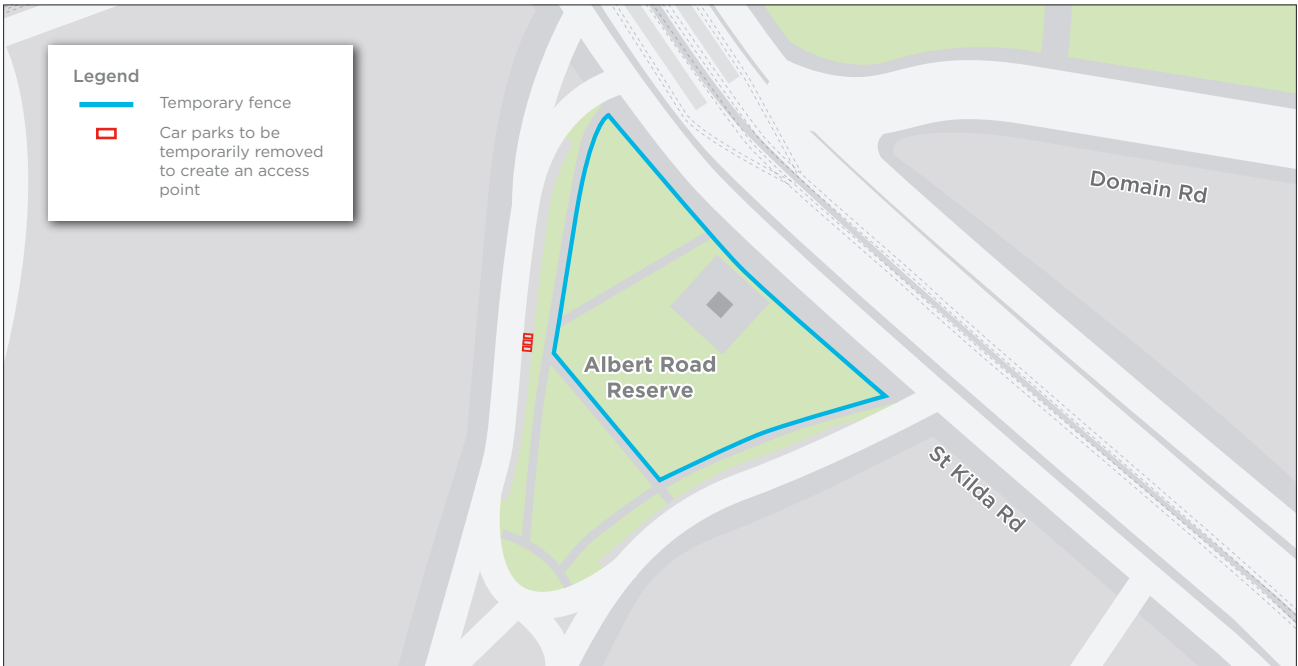
What to be aware of

- The relevant Heritage Victoria permit for the removal and storage of the South African Soldiers Memorial and the John Cockbill Memorial Drinking Fountain has been received
- The removal and storage activity will be overseen by a Heritage Victoria approved Heritage Conservation Consultant and carried out by suitably qualified specialists within this field

Please note that this is indicative only for the South African Soldiers Memorial site works and does not include the existing South Yarra Main Sewer site set up.

- The access point into site will be used to enable the safe removal of the sections of the memorial from site for storage
- There will be some periods of medium-high level noise. These will be managed in accordance with the Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs) established for the project
- Some night works may be required however we will notify you in advance of these works.
