CCTV INSTALLATION - INTERSECTION OF VICTORIA AND RATHDOWNE STREET 10 APRIL TO 13 APRIL 2018

Ahead of major construction for the Metro Tunnel Project, changes to the road, tram and bicycle networks are required to keep Melbourne moving during construction.

These enhancements will include signalling upgrades at more than 100 intersections and the installation of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras and Bluetooth technology on alternative routes to allow for more real-time monitoring and improved incident response.

What we are doing

Prior to the installation of CCTV and Bluetooth technology at the intersection of Victoria Street and Rathdowne Street, we will be undertaking night works to install a new VicRoads communication cabinet.

When


- Tuesday 10 April to Friday 13 April 2018, 9:30am – 3:30pm
- CCTV and Bluetooth installation will take a shift to complete following the VicRoads cabinet installation.

What to be aware of

- Works will involve saw cutting the asphalt, using non-destructive digging, excavation and asphalt reinstatement. These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- CCTV and Bluetooth installation works will generate low levels of noise
- Short term lane closures will be required, and traffic management will be in place around the work site to manage the safety of pedestrians, vehicles and cyclists.
