



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SITE INVESTIGATIONS & CABLE REPAIR WORKS – FEDERATION SQUARE, MELBOURNE **MONDAY 7 MAY TO WEDNESDAY 16 MAY 2018**

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are ramping up in 2018, with the Cross Yarra Partnership (CYP) selected as the contractor to build the Tunnel and Stations Package.

In preparation for these works, CYP is undertaking a range of site investigations between Kensington and South Yarra from September 2017 until May 2018.

Extensive investigations have previously been undertaken along the corridor to assess ground and environmental conditions, and these latest investigations will build on this work to finalise CYP's design and construction methodology for the twin nine kilometre tunnels and five underground stations.

What we are doing

Performing cable repair works along Princes Walk (see map overleaf). This involves:

- Setting up a fenced temporary work site
- Excavating a shallow trench along the edge of Princes Walk
- Installing an electrical conduit
- Connecting the cable back into the electrical system
- Reinstating the surface to its original (or similar) condition.

Installing four groundwater monitoring wells along Princes Walk (see map overleaf). This involves:

- Non-destructive drilling to locate underground services

- Setting up a small fenced temporary work site
- A small crew using a drill to install the well, and backfilling the hole around it
- Reinstating the surface with a small metal capping plate that sits flush to the ground
- Returning to check the well periodically to undertake tests and collect data.

Testing the four groundwater monitoring wells along Princes Walk (see map overleaf). This involves:

- Collecting water from groundwater monitoring wells
- Setting up a small fenced temporary work site
- Measuring the standing water level
- Installing water level data loggers
- Establishing temporary portable water supplies
- Fitting required pressure and flow valves to the groundwater monitoring wells to complete testing
- Reinstating the sites to their original (or similar) condition.

- Active traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, and cyclists around the work areas
- Access to businesses will be maintained at all times during these works.

What to be aware of

- There will be high levels of noise during excavation, ground breaking and non-destructive drilling activities
- The noise generated by subsequent drilling activities will be similar to that of an idle truck engine
