



WORKS NOTIFICATION

LOCAL SEWER DIVERSION AND WATER MAIN WORKS, DOMAIN 17 OCTOBER – EARLY DECEMBER 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway in Domain to support construction of a new underground station.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works, which includes the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

Local sewer diversion works

Sewer diversion works will involve installing a new sewer pipe beneath the St Kilda Road service lane, between Domain Road and Bromby Street, and then across St Kilda Road to Bowen Crescent where it will connect into the existing sewer.

These works will involve:

- Excavating three manholes from which the bore will be launched and retrieved
- Laser boring between three manholes beneath St Kilda Road and in Bowen Crescent to install the new sewer pipe
- Connecting the newly installed sewer pipe to the existing sewer main on the north side of St Kilda Road and in Bowen Crescent.

Water main works

Water main installation works will involve installing a section of water pipe beneath the St Kilda Road kerbside lane, adjacent to Melbourne Grammar School.

These works will involve:

- Saw-cutting the road surface and footpath
- Open cut trenching involving excavating down to the required depth, installing the new water main and backfilling the trench
- Reinstating the road pavement and footpath.

When

St Kilda Road (southbound lanes)

- 7am - 3pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

Bowen Crescent

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

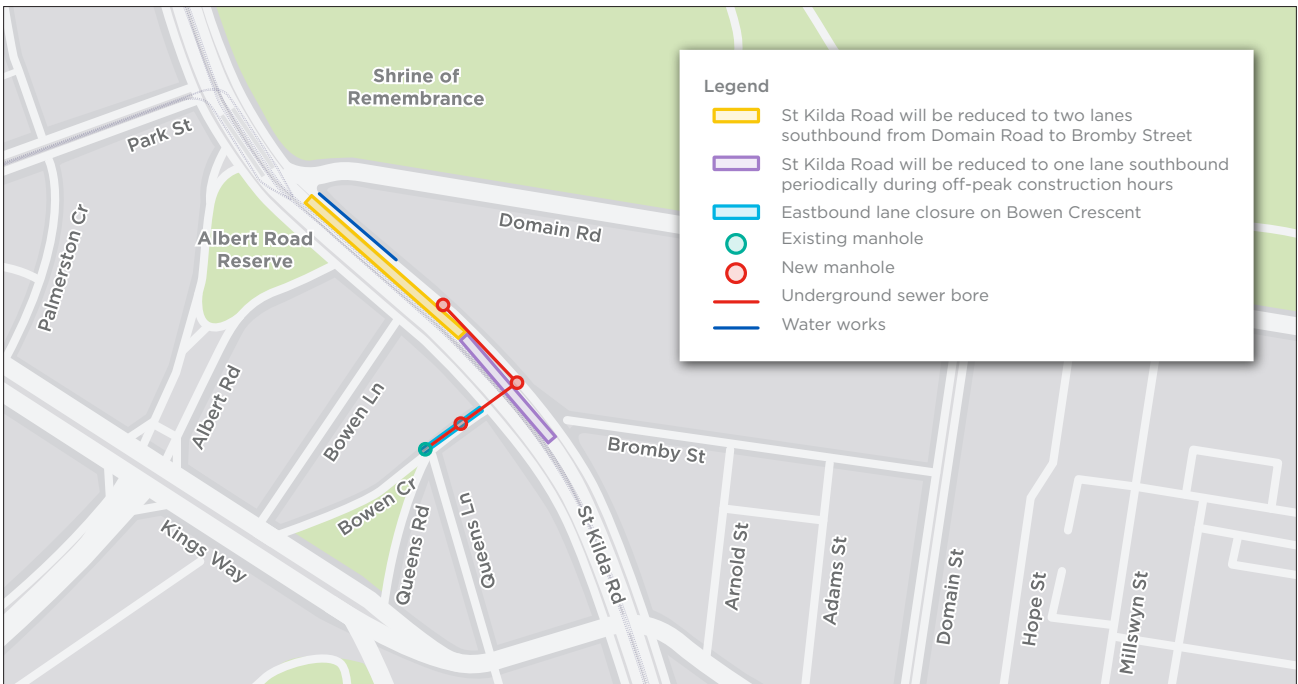
All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

What to be aware of

- There will be periods of medium to high level noise associated with excavation of the three manholes, sawcutting the road and open cut trenching
- Impacts from noise, vibration and dust will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements
- Property driveway access will be maintained.


Traffic impacts

- St Kilda Road will be reduced to two lanes southbound from Domain Road to Bromby Street
- Periodically during these works, an additional lane will be closed to undertake works between 7am - 3pm, reducing St Kilda to one southbound lane at these times
- Steel plates will be placed over excavations on St Kilda Road to enable lanes to be reopened during peak times
- From late October Bowen Crescent will be closed to eastbound traffic between St Kilda Road and Queens Lane with localised detours in place
- Melbourne Grammar School's driveway will be accessible via St Kilda Road under traffic management, however visitors will be encouraged to use the Bromby St driveway during these works.
