



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SITE ESTABLISHMENT AND SERVICE RELOCATIONS, PARKVILLE 25 MAY 2017 TO EARLY AUGUST

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

Service relocation

- Further to our notice dated 23 March, works are continuing within University of Melbourne land along Grattan Street to install drainage, water and sewer mains
- These services will be installed by open cut trenching, consisting of excavating a trench and manually installing each piece of pipe, backfilling and reinstating the area.

Site establishment

- A tree will be removed on Grattan Street (opposite Leicester Street) to prepare the site for service installation. Chainsaws, excavators and boom lifts will be used.

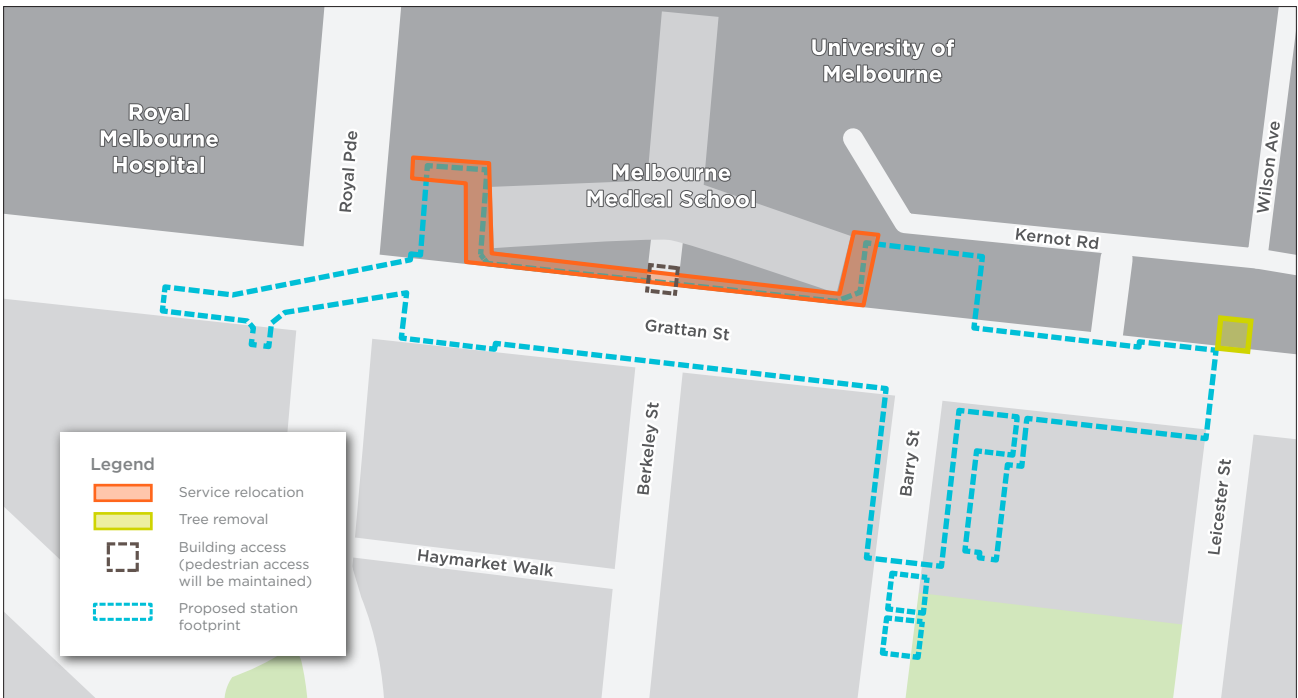
What to be aware of

- There will be an eastbound lane closure on Grattan Street between Barry Street and Bouverie Street for one day on either Thursday 25 May or Friday 26 May between 9:30am - 3:30pm
- We will need to occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Grattan Street as the works progress
- Fauna associated with the tree to be removed will be assessed and managed appropriately
- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There will be some temporary pedestrian and cyclist diversions required
- There is no planned disruption to essential services
- Melbourne Metro Rail Authority will replant at least two trees for every tree removed for construction of the Metro Tunnel to enhance long term canopy cover across the Metro Tunnel project.
