



WORKS NOTIFICATION

PARKVILLE WORKS UPDATE DECEMBER 2017 – JANUARY 2018

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

Further to the Parkville works update notification released in October 2017, service relocation works and road network changes are continuing across Parkville through December 2017 and January 2018.

The majority of work will take place during normal working hours:

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays

Some out of hours works are required for certain activities. Details of these works are included in this notification.

Cable hauling works

Ongoing until late January

Cable hauling works in Royal Parade and Elizabeth Street are continuing until late January 2018.

Additional cable hauling works will commence within University of Melbourne land, and in the footpath on the north side of Grattan Street near Gate 10, between Barry and Leicester streets.

These works include excavating across the footpath and into the Grattan Street kerb.

- Royal Parade southbound service lanes will be closed intermittently between 10am and 10pm, for pit access. During closures, cyclists will be diverted onto the shared path, and bus routes 401 and 402 will use the centre carriageway
- Pedestrian diversions are in place on the footpaths on the west side of Royal Parade, both sides of Elizabeth Street, and the north side of Grattan Street
- Excavation works will generate medium-high levels of noise
- Works in existing pits will generate low levels of noise.

Site compound, Barry Street

Ongoing until 22 December

A fenced site compound is in place in the northbound lane of Barry Street to support reinstatement works.

- Site is primarily used to safely store materials and plant, and for staff facilities
- Minor works to support reinstatement activities may occur within the site during normal working hours
- This site is being progressively de-mobilised throughout December
- There is no left turn into Barry Street from Pelham Street.

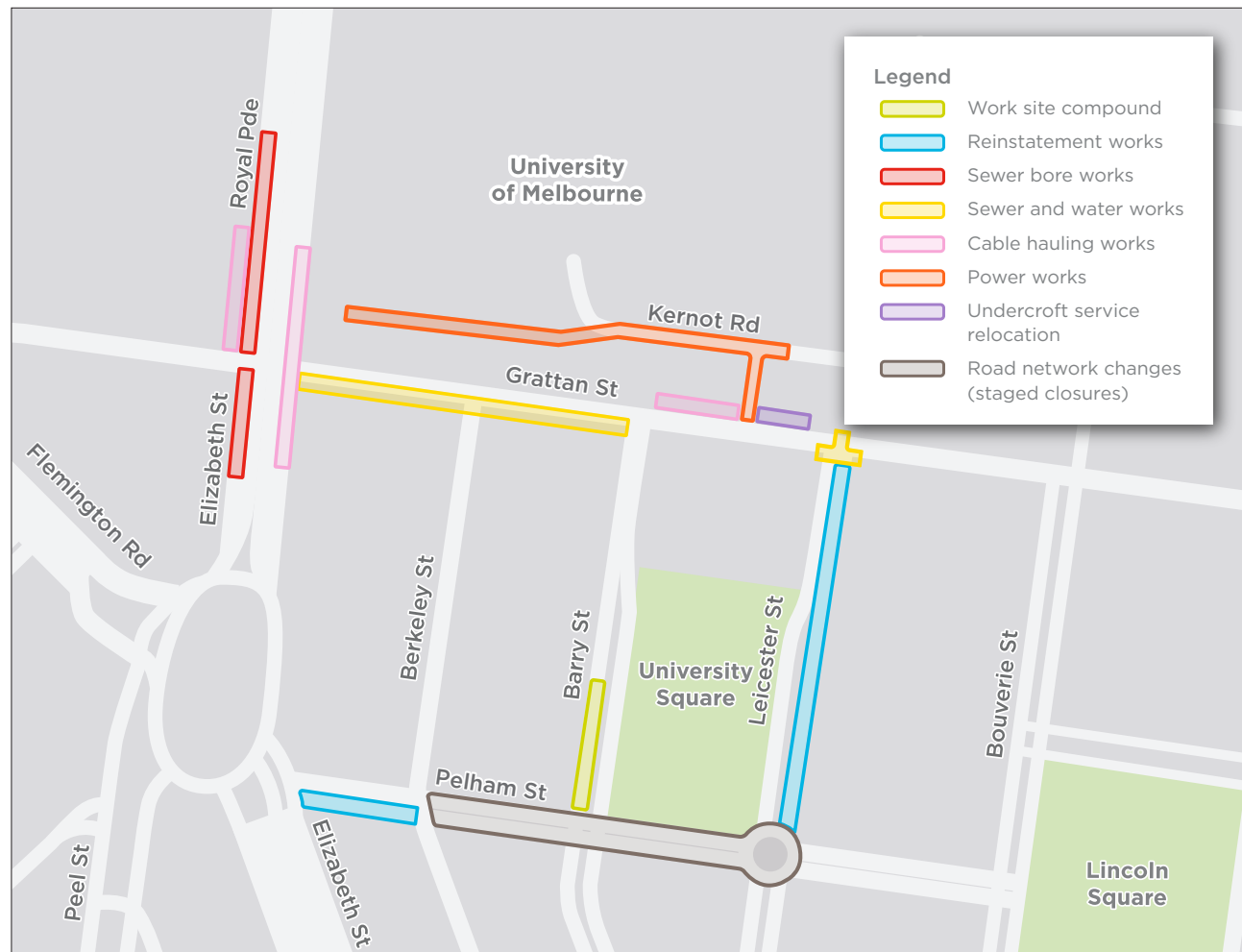

Reinstatement works

Ongoing until late January

Road reinstatement works have commenced in areas where service relocations are complete.

- Reinstating the asphalt in Pelham, Leicester, Barry, Grattan and Elizabeth streets, and within University of Melbourne land
- The compound on Barry Street will remain but in a reduced capacity until end of December
- Asphalt reinstatement works include the use of an asphalt paver and vibratory roller
- These works will generate medium-high levels of noise
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic. Please refer to signage in the area

Further notice, with traffic management details, will be provided ahead of works commencing.

Sewer works, Royal Parade

Ongoing until late December

Works to install a new sewer by boring in the Royal Parade northbound service lanes are continuing at night. These works are on track and will be completed in late December.

- Lane closures are in place on the Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade northbound service lanes, from 8pm - 6am every night
- Traffic management is in place in the Grattan Street westbound lanes, between Royal Parade and Berkeley Street, from 8pm - 6am every night. Westbound through-traffic is diverted, with only left and right turning movements permitted at Royal Parade.
- Some saw cutting will be required, and will generate high levels of noise. This work will be undertaken earlier in the night to minimise impacts
- Boring works will create medium levels of noise.

Out of hours works:

- Ongoing until late December 2017
- 6pm - 7am, Monday to Sunday.

Water and sewer works, Grattan Street

Ongoing until late December

Works to install the new water and sewer mains in the footpath on the south side of Grattan Street, between Elizabeth and Barry streets, are continuing until late December.

- Berkeley Street is closed 24/7 at the intersection with Grattan Street. Access to the University Square car park is maintained via Pelham Street
- A westbound lane closure is in place in Grattan Street during working hours
- Pedestrian diversions are in place on the south side of Grattan Street
- These works will generate medium-high levels of noise.

Power works, University of Melbourne

Power works within the University of Melbourne are continuing. These works include installing conduits outside the Medical Building and along Kernot Road to Gate 10, constructing a pit in the Medical Building forecourt, and constructing a pit in the Kernot Road Gate 10 car park. These works are on track and will be completed in late December.

- Access to buildings will be maintained throughout the works
- Traffic management is in place 24/7 in Kernot Road
- Pedestrian diversions will be required around the work areas
- These works will generate medium-high levels of noise.

Out of hours works:

- Constructing the pit and conduit tie-ins in the Kernot Road Gate 10 car park
- 6pm - 7am Monday to Friday
- 7am - 6pm Saturdays and Sundays.

Service relocation works, University of Melbourne

Late December until late February 2018

Service relocation works in the undercroft of the Engineering Building have been delayed and will now take place late December 2017 until late February 2018.

- Traffic management will be in place at Gate 10, and there will be an eastbound lane closure on Grattan Street
- Pedestrian diversions will be required around the work area, inside University of Melbourne land and on Grattan Street
- These works will generate medium-high levels of noise

Further notice will be provided ahead of these works commencing.

Sewer pit construction and water main crossing of Grattan Street and Leicester Street

Late December until late February 2018

Works to install a new water main across Grattan Street, near Leicester Street, have been delayed and will now take place late December 2017 until late February 2018.

Additionally, a sewer pit will be constructed in the same location in the westbound lane of Grattan Street near the corner of Grattan Street and Leicester Street.

- Staged east and westbound lane closures will be in place on Grattan Street between Bouverie and Barry streets
- There will be no vehicle access to Leicester Street from Grattan Street during the works
- These works will generate medium-high levels of noise.

Further notice will be provided ahead of these works commencing.

CCTV Installation

18 December to early January 2018

Prior to the installation of CCTV and Bluetooth technology at the intersection of Princes and Lygon Streets and at the intersection of Elizabeth and Queensberry Street, we will be undertaking night works to remove asbestos from the traffic signal pit.

- Asbestos removal will be carried out by accredited subcontractors (who are specialist removers of asbestos), using safe handling and disposal procedures in accordance with the WorkSafe Compliance Code and relevant industry standards.
- This activity will involve setting up plastic lined temporary fencing around the work area, asbestos removal and air quality monitoring.
- There may be some medium level noise associated with these works.
- Short term lane closures will be required, and traffic management will be in place around the work site to manage the safety of pedestrians, vehicles and cyclists.

Out of hours works:

- Asbestos removal (from 18 December - 22 December 2017) 6pm - 7am
- CCTV and Bluetooth installation will take 1-2 days to complete and will commence once asbestos removal is completed. Installation works will be undertaken during day time hours of 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday, or 7am-1pm, Saturday.



Changes to road network, Pelham Street

Ongoing until late January

Further to the works notification issued on 28 November regarding road network changes, these works will require the staged closure of Pelham Street.

- From now until 22 December, Pelham Street will remain closed in both directions between Leicester Street and Barry Street
- Pelham Street will be reopened from the 23 December until works resume in early January 2018
- From early January until late January 2018, Pelham Street will be closed between Leicester and Barry Street with no access into Pelham Street from Leicester Street
- Localised closures will be required at the Leicester and Barry Street intersections for short durations during January 2018 to carry out specific works. Further notification will be provided to directly impacted businesses and residents.

Cross Yarra Partnership (CYP) site investigations, Parkville

Ongoing until March 2018

Geotechnical drilling and the installation of groundwater monitoring wells has commenced in Parkville.


- Temporary impacts to on-street parking
- Some temporary single-lane closures required to facilitate works
- Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained and traffic management will be in place.

Further notice, including traffic management details, will be provided ahead of works commencing.
