



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SERVICE RELOCATIONS, PARKVILLE 20 NOVEMBER – LATE DECEMBER 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are continuing in Parkville to support construction of a new underground station.

Currently these works include the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

Service relocations

Installing a new sewer by boring in the Royal Parade northbound service lanes, including:

Day works

- Service proving including non-destructive digging (NDD) and saw cutting.

Night works

- Excavating a shaft in the outer westbound lane of Grattan Street, in the intersection with Royal Parade
- Excavating a shaft in the northbound service lanes of Royal Parade
- Installing a new sewer in the northbound service lanes of Royal Parade, using an underground boring rig to bore a path beneath the surface between the entry and exit shafts.

What to be aware of

- Lane closures will be in place on the Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade northbound service lanes, from 8pm – 6am every night
- There will be traffic management in place in the westbound lanes on Grattan Street between Royal Parade and Berkeley Street, between 8pm - 6am

every night. Westbound through traffic will be diverted, with only left and right turning traffic movements permitted at Royal Parade. This traffic management will be coordinated with other works

- There will be some temporary pedestrian diversions required
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Temporary fencing will be erected around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- The saw cutting is expected to generate high levels of noise, the boring will be medium levels
- We will make every effort to complete noisier activities early in the evening to minimise disruption during night works
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic. Please refer to signage in the area
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

When

Day works

- Monday 20 November until late December 2017
- 7am – 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am – 1pm, Saturdays.

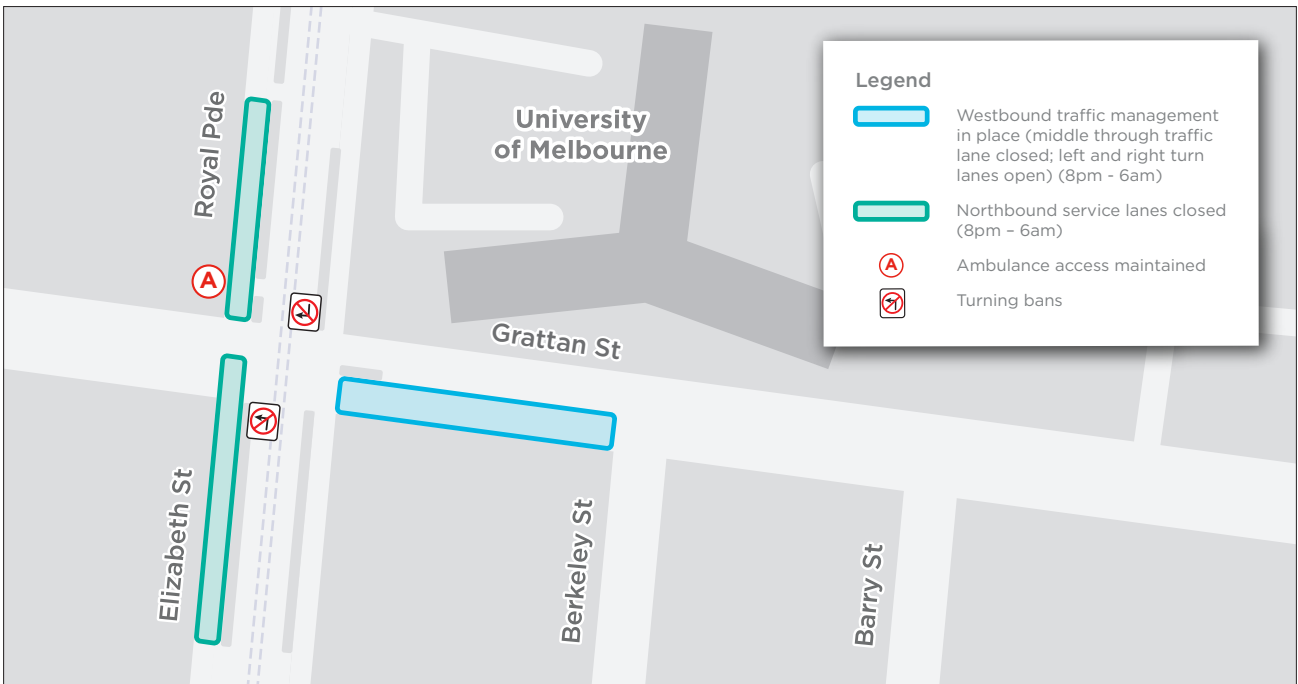
Night works

- 6pm – 7am, Monday to Sunday.
