



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SITE ESTABLISHMENT PARKVILLE 27 APRIL TO 8 MAY 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes site establishment, tree and vegetation removal, and the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

- Removing a limited number of trees on Royal Parade and Grattan Street, using chainsaws, excavators and boom lifts
- Relocating a statue at the entrance to the Melbourne Medical School (University of Melbourne) to facilitate relocation of services.

What to be aware of

- A southbound vehicle and bicycle lane closure will be in place on Royal Parade between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street on Saturday 28 April and Sunday 29 April
- A westbound lane closure will be in place on Grattan Street between Berkeley Street and Barry Street on Saturday 6 May and Sunday 7 May
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic

- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times, including access to the Melbourne Medical School during statue relocation
- There will be some temporary pedestrian diversions required
- We will need to occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Grattan Street at the works location
- Fauna associated with trees to be removed will be assessed and managed appropriately
- As Royal Parade is on the Victorian Heritage Register, a heritage permit application for these works has been approved by Heritage Victoria
- Melbourne Metro Rail Authority will replant at least two trees for every tree removed for construction of the Metro Tunnel to enhance long term canopy cover across the Metro Tunnel project.

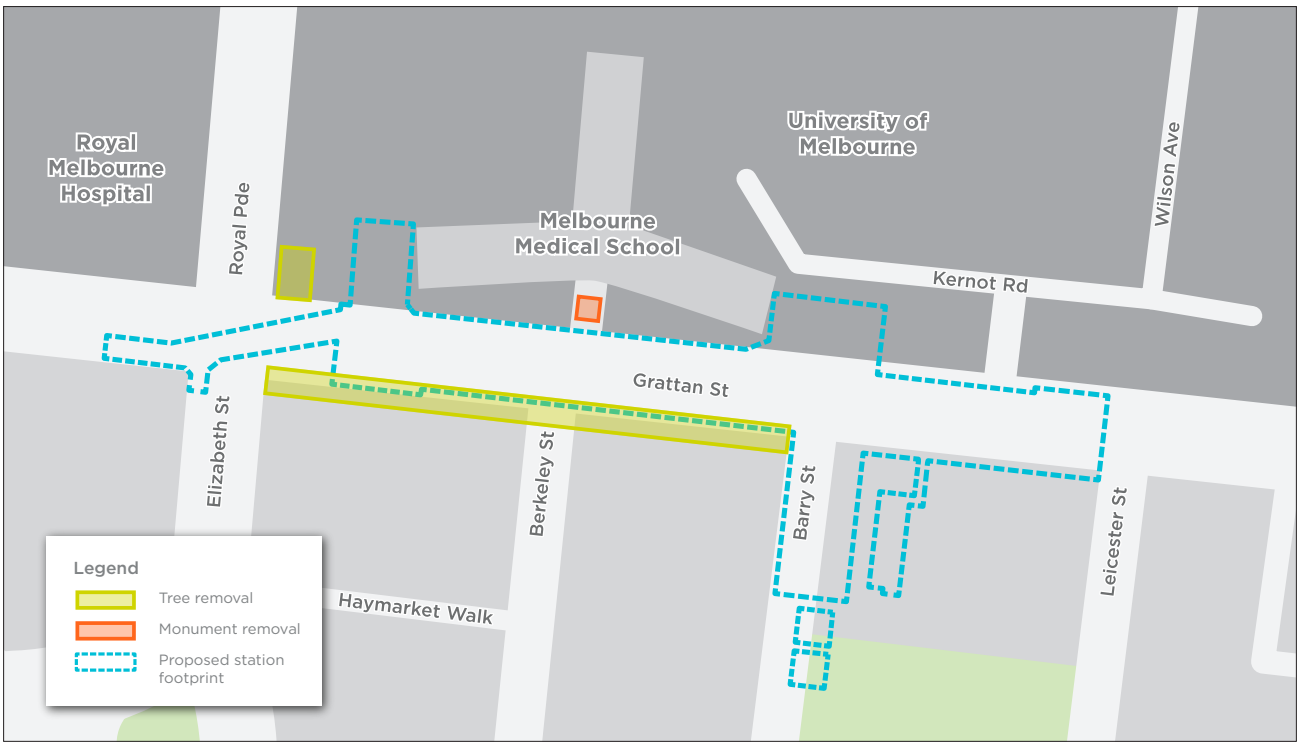
Day works
