



WORKS NOTIFICATION

CITY SQUARE SITE MOBILISATION, CBD PRECINCT 10 - 18 MAY 2018

Works in preparation for major construction of the new Town Hall Station are about to ramp up again at the City Square site. The next phase of construction for Town Hall Station involves site mobilisation and site investigations in preparation for piling.

What we are doing

- Delivering large equipment, including an excavator to the City Square site, via the entrance on Flinders Lane
- Closing the northern footpath on Flinders Lane, between Swanston and Regent streets
- Diverting pedestrians to the southern footpath.

What to be aware of

- Traffic on Flinders Lane will be temporarily stopped for up to 3 minutes at intermittent times to allow for the safe delivery of site equipment
- Traffic controllers will be on site to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and road users around the work area
- Access for residents and businesses will be maintained during these works
- These works are expected to generate moderate-high levels of noise.

When

- 7am-6pm, Thursday 10 May 2018 (equipment delivery)
- 7am-6pm, Thursday 10 - Friday 18 May 2018 (site mobilisation).

If works cannot be completed on these days they will be completed on the next available day. Please note, that there may be some days during this period where works do not take place.
