



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### SERVICE RELOCATION, PARKVILLE 16 JUNE 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

Further to our previous notification distributed on 20 April, works are continuing to relocate the gas main along Pelham Street.

The section of main between Elizabeth Street and Berkeley Street has now been completed and this section of the road has been reopened to traffic.

#### What we are doing

##### Service Relocations

- Installation of the gas main is now continuing in the section between Berkeley Street and Leicester Street
- There will continue to be staged closures of Pelham Street as works progress. The section between Berkeley Street and Leicester Street is currently closed and this will be followed by a closure between Leicester Street and Bouverie Street
- Between the Leicester Street roundabout and Bouverie Street, the main will be installed using a surface launched drilling rig to bore a path beneath the surface between an entry and exit point

- Installation of the new gas main will then continue on Bouverie Street between Pelham Street and Grattan Street by open cut trenching, with two blocks closed at any one time.

##### Service investigation

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services within University of Melbourne land
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service (including in footpaths and roads).

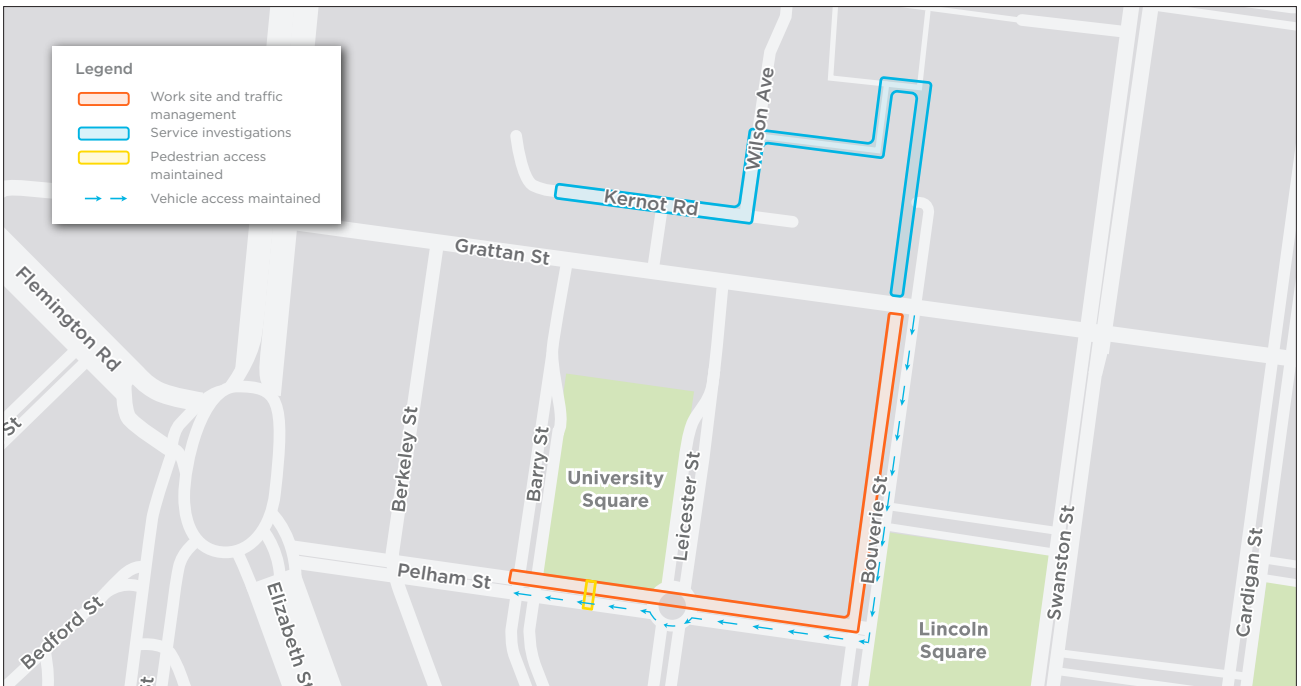
##### What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing will be erected around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- We will need to temporarily occupy a limited number of parking spaces on Pelham Street and Bouverie Street as the works progress
- There will be temporary changes to the 505 bus stop on Pelham Street as the works progress, please refer to signage
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic. Please refer to signage in the area
- There may be some temporary pedestrian diversions
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

- From Monday 26 June 2017, until late July
- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturday

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

### What's next

- From late July, the gas main will be installed under Haymarket roundabout using a surface launch drill rig from Pelham Street, with lane closures in place
- Further notifications will be provided prior to works commencing.

### Keeping the community informed

John Holland understands that there will be some unavoidable impacts from these works, and is committed to keeping the community and stakeholders informed of all works and any expected impacts, before they occur.
