



# NIGHT WORKS UPDATE

## SOUTH YARRA MAIN SEWER EXTENDED HOURS AND NIGHT WORKS

### WORKS COMMENCING 20 SEPTEMBER 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Domain.

Further to the South Yarra Main Sewer Works Overview notification issued on 2 April 2017 and subsequent updates, please be advised of the following upcoming works to complete the new sewer main and the sewer diversion from the existing main.

#### What we are doing

##### 20 September to 22 September (as required)

Extended construction hours until 10pm may be required to complete the excavation of the tunnel boring machine (TBM) retrieval shaft in Domain Road in preparation to retrieve the TBM.

This will involve using an excavator placed within the shaft with a rock breaker attachment below the surface to excavate material. A surface based crane will then retrieve the material and store it on the surface.

##### From early October

From early to mid-October, we will be using a surface-based crane to lower the prefabricated pipe into the Albert Road and Domain Road shafts, and using hand tools to place the pipe between the shafts. These works will take place at the Albert Road site in early October, and at the Domain Road site from mid-October in preparation for the sewer connection.

This work will take approximately one week at each location. We will provide you with further notification once the date of these works is confirmed.

#### What to be aware of

- Excavated materials will be stored on site during extended construction hours and removed during the day
- There may be periods of medium-high level noise associated with excavation and using hand tools to place the prefabricated pipe in the shaft
- Impacts from noise will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements.

##### Wednesday 20 September to Friday 22 September (as required)

- 7am - 10pm

##### From early October (for approximately one week at each site)

- 6pm - 7am, Monday to Saturday
