



WORKS NOTIFICATION

NIGHT WORKS, KENSINGTON 15 - 18 DECEMBER 2017

Works in preparation for major construction of the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway across Melbourne. In Kensington, these works include the removal and relocation of high voltage (HV) transmission towers along Childers Street.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works.

What we are doing

To undertake the construction of a new HV tower south of the rail corridor, an access crossing for construction and emergency vehicles needs to be installed across the freight rail tracks.

Works will include:

- Removal of existing asphalt
- Line marking and rail protection coating applications
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) around the construction area to create pole holes for a fence along the access path between two of the HV Towers
- Laying new asphalt.

What to be aware of

Due to the need to occupy a section of rail track to construct the crossing, these works need to take place at night when trains aren't running.

These works will result in intermittent levels of high noise. However, on most nights the noise levels are expected to be in the low to medium range.

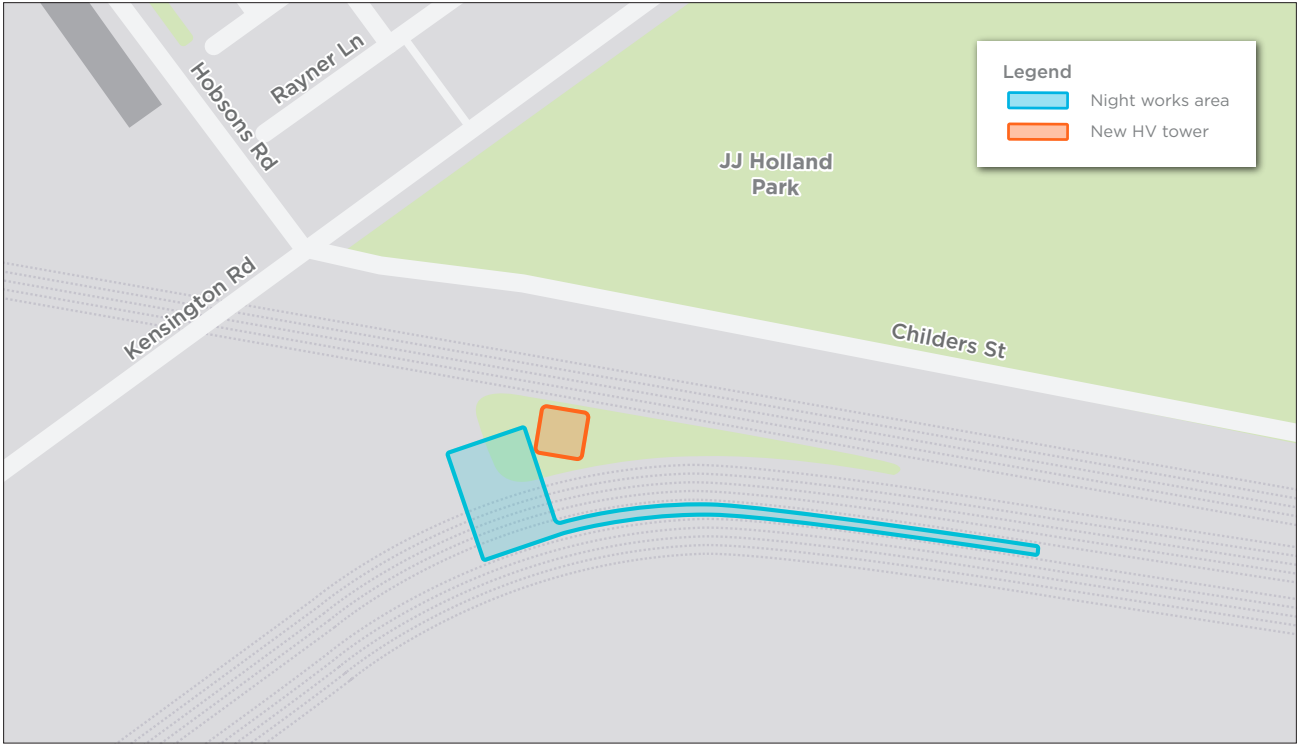
