



WORKS NOTIFICATION

CONNECTING THE TEMPORARY ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION ON EDMUND HERRING OVAL TO EXISTING POWER ASSETS

8 JANUARY - 28 FEBRUARY 2018

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of the new Anzac Station in Domain.

At Edmund Herring Oval, work has commenced on a temporary electrical substation to provide power for the tunnel boring machines that will build the Metro Tunnel.

What we are doing

The next phase of work on the temporary electrical substation involves connecting the substation to existing power assets. This will involve trenching and cable works from Domain Road to the temporary electrical substation on the south side of Edmund Herring Oval.

What to be aware of

Site Mobilisation

- A site compound will be established to support delivery of the power connection
- The compound will be used as a temporary site office for staff
- Access to the site will be via Dallas Brooks Drive

Construction

- Temporary fencing will be installed around the entire work site to ensure the safety of the community
- On-site staff parking will be provided to minimise impacts on public car parking

- Traffic management measures may be required to ensure the safety of work crews and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There may be some temporary pedestrian diversions required
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise, particularly during trenching and excavation works

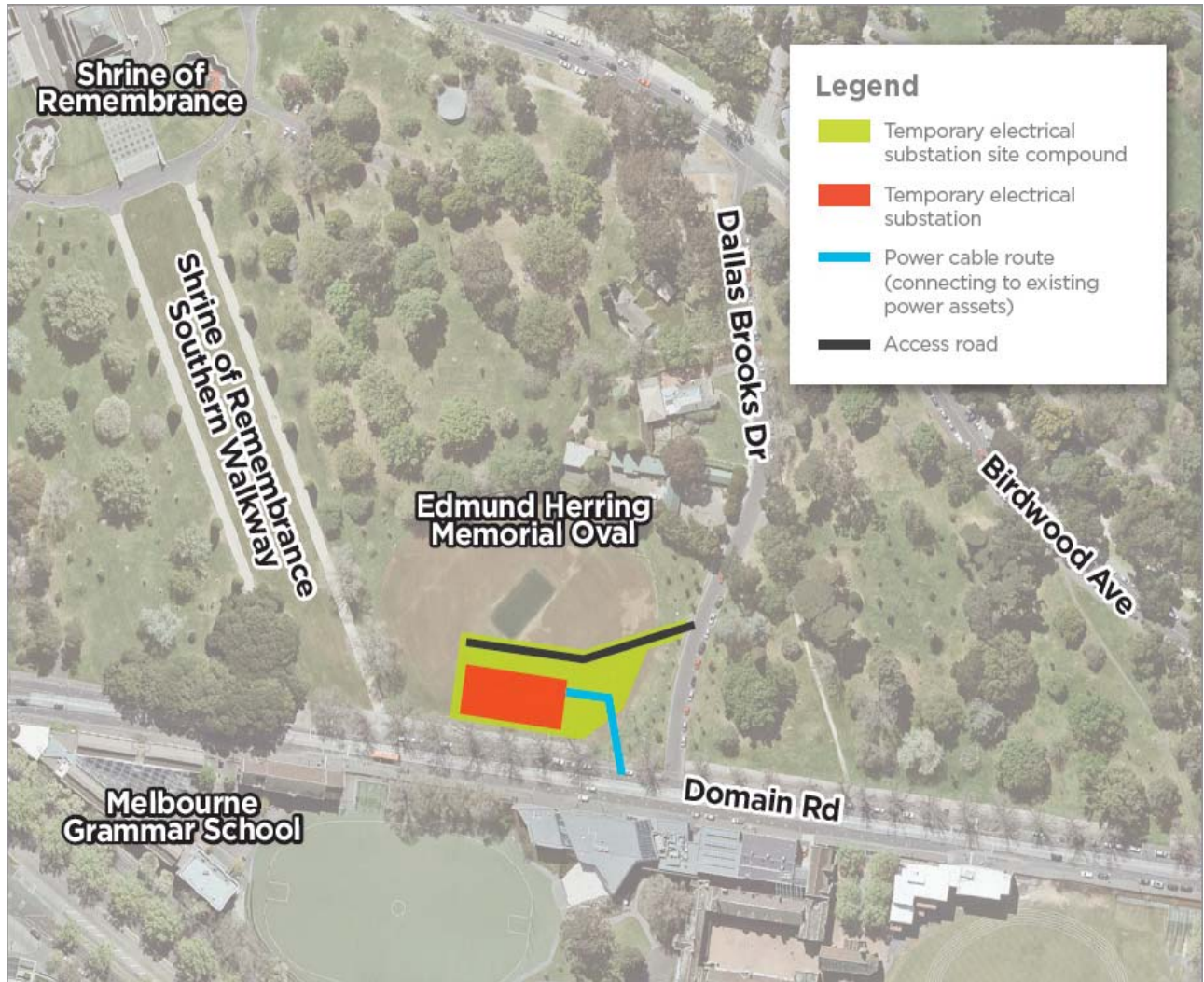
When

Site mobilisation and construction works will occur concurrently and will take place during normal working hours:








- Monday 8 January to Wednesday 28 February 2018
- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturdays


Should works outside of these hours be required, we will notify you in advance.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.
