CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – TRAFFIC CHANGES, CITY SQUARE 15 JULY 2017

Major construction on the Metro Tunnel is underway to support the construction of a CBD underground station with direct connections to Flinders Street Station.

John Holland is the Managing Contractor for this package of works.

What we are doing

As preparatory works continue ahead of major shaft construction, there will be some changes to the truck routes in and out of the City Square site.

From 15 July, trucks will enter City Square via Flinders Lane and exit via Collins Street. This new route will support the next phase of construction.

Demolition works will continue in City Square to prepare the site for shaft excavation.

To facilitate the truck route changes, the following work will be undertaken:

Night works

- On the evening of 6 July, work will be carried out on Collins Street to build a new driveway for the City Square site
- These works will be undertaken between 10pm-7am to lessen impacts on the Collins Street tram corridor and because it requires pedestrian footpath closures

- Works will include saw cutting and bluestone removal. A road saw will be used which will cause high intermittent noise impacts
- Once civil and driveway building is completed, line marking will be carried out on Collins Street
- Pedestrian detours will be in place on Collins Street and contraflow for vehicles and cyclists moving westbound on Collins Street. Traffic control will be in place
- All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions
- We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

What to be aware of

- Traffic management will be in place during construction to maintain the flow of traffic and ensure the safety of work crews and pedestrians
- Some construction plant and equipment will be moved onto the site at night to minimise impacts on pedestrians and traffic
- There may be some noise and dust associated with these works. Mitigation strategies which comply with Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs) will be put in place to minimise disruption to the community.
