



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SERVICE RELOCATIONS, PARKVILLE 2 OCTOBER UNTIL LATE-NOVEMBER 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which involves the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

Service relocations

- Installing new power conduits in the Royal Parade southbound service lanes, and across the intersection with Grattan Street
- Constructing a power pit in the Royal Parade southbound service lanes
- Installing new drainage culverts in the Royal Parade southbound service lanes, and across the intersection with Grattan Street
- Power conduits and drainage culverts will be installed by open-cut trenching, consisting of saw-cutting the road, excavating a trench and manually installing each piece of pipe, backfilling and reinstating the area.

What to be aware of

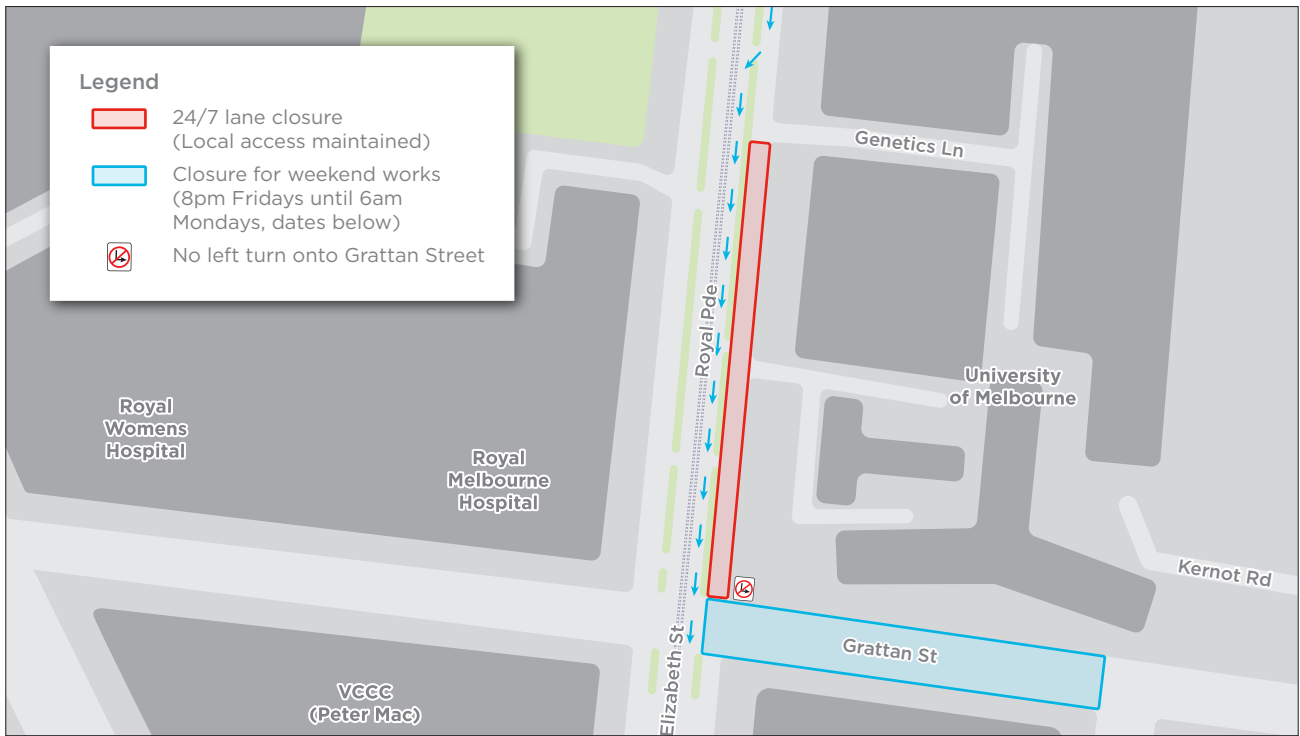
- Royal Parade southbound service lanes will be closed between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street. Southbound access will be maintained via the centre carriageway lane. There will be no left turn into Grattan Street during this time
- Royal Parade southbound bicycle lane will be detoured to the existing shared use path

- Grattan Street will be closed between Royal Parade and Berkeley Street over four weekends in October and November (refer to dates below)
- Tram services along Royal Parade will not be impacted by these works
- Bus routes 505 and 546 travelling southbound on Royal Parade will be detoured along the centre carriageway, between College Crescent and Grattan Street. Temporary bus stops will be provided on the median strip
- Bus routes 401, 402, 403, 505 and 546 will be diverted around the work area on Grattan Street

- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain the flow of traffic. Please refer to signage in the area
- Works will be carried out 24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday between 2 October and late-November
- There will be periods of medium to high level noise associated with these works
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

Royal Parade southbound service lane closures

- From 2 October until 16 November 2017
- 24 hours per day, Monday to Sunday

Grattan Street closed between Royal Parade and Berkeley Street


- Weekends of 13-16, 20-23 & 27-30 October and 10-13 November
- 8pm Fridays until 6am Mondays
- Works will be carried out 24/7

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.
