



PARK STREET TRAM STOP PROJECT

14 JANUARY TO 17 FEBRUARY 2018

Building new tram infrastructure in Park Street, South Melbourne is an important next step in keeping Melburnians moving during construction of the Metro Tunnel Project. The Park Street Tram Stop Development Plan was released for public consultation in August 2017, and approved by the Minister for Planning in October 2017.

The new Park Street tram stop will be located to the west of Wells Street and Palmerston Crescent, and will replace the existing stop 119 which is currently located at the intersection of Kings Way and Park Street.

The stop will have the capacity to safely cater for the increasing number of passengers on the route 58 tram, and will provide improved access to the tram network during and following completion of the Metro Tunnel Project.

The new tram stop requires the removal of 26 on-street parking spaces to maintain one lane of traffic in each direction. It will also involve changes to the

intersection of Wells Street and Palmerston Crescent to allow for safe vehicle turning movements and tram operations.

Yarra Trams is responsible for delivering the tram works in Park Street, which will occur in stages. This brochure includes an outline of the various stages, dates, work hours and construction activities that will be undertaken between 8 January and 17 February 2018. Noise, traffic and transport impacts are also outlined.

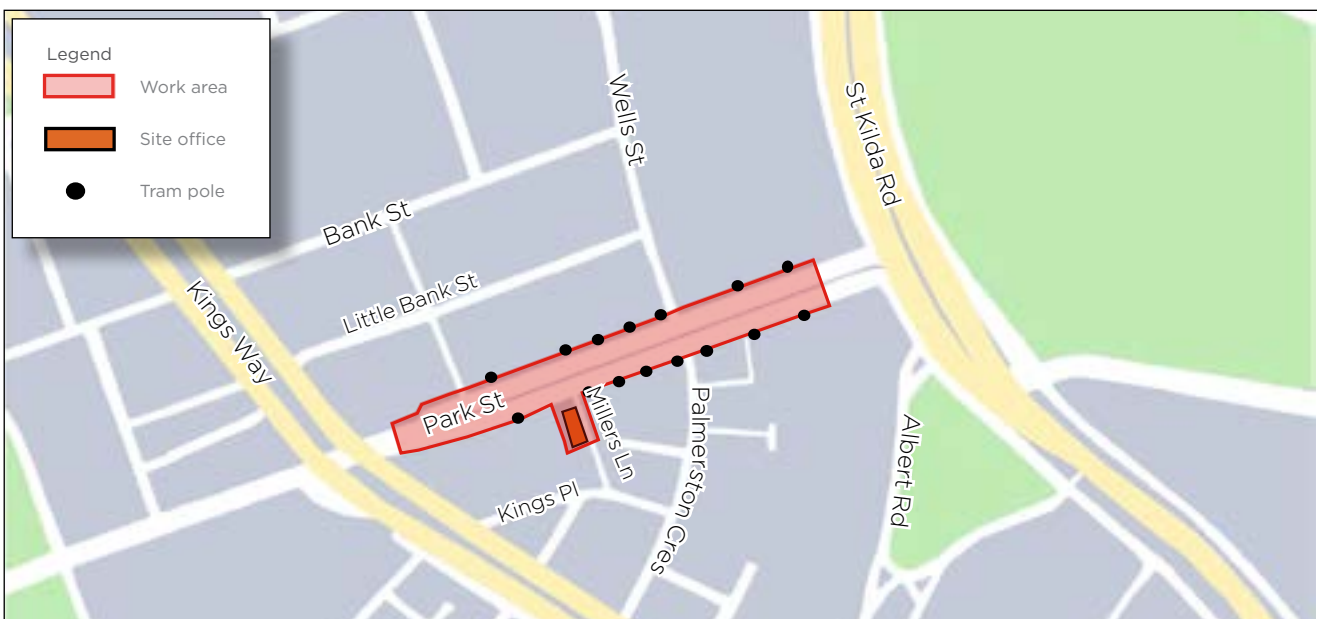

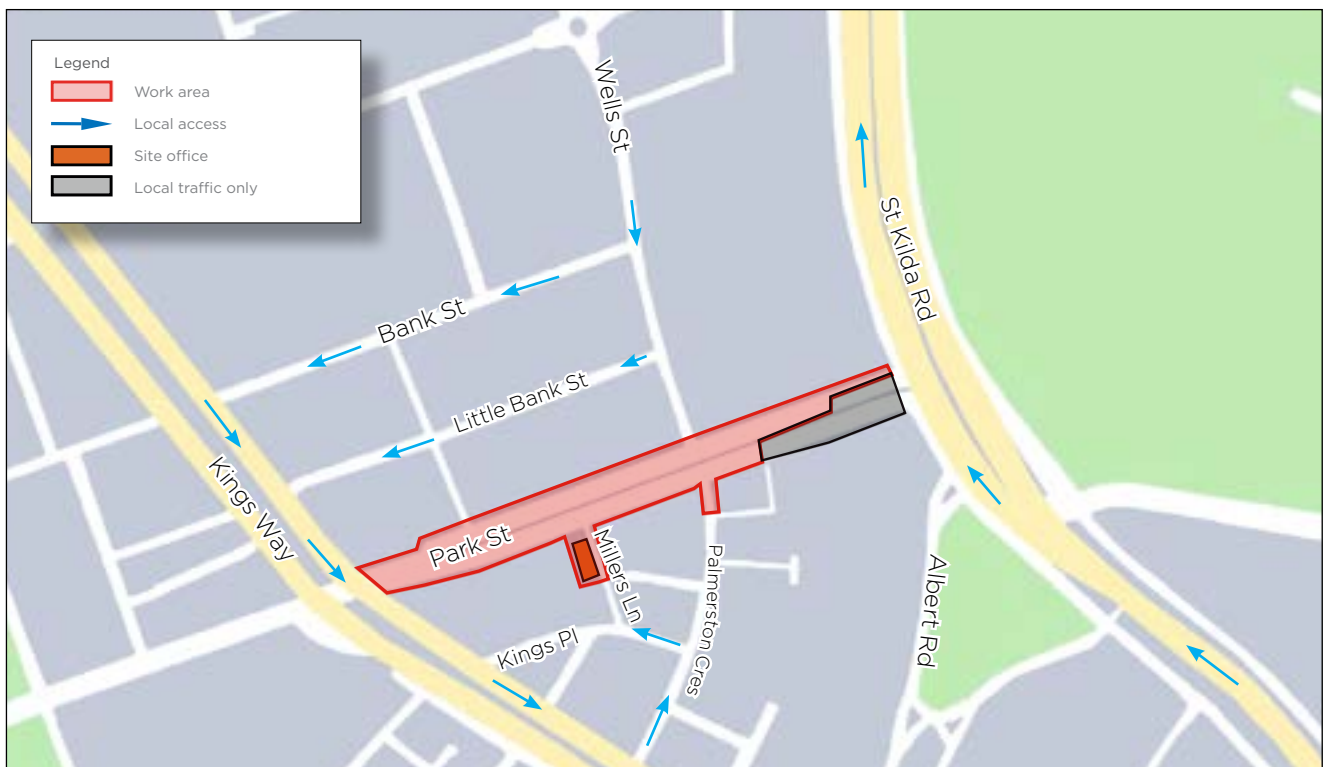

Buses will replace route 58 tram services.
