### UPCOMING NIGHT WORKS SUNDAY 6 MAY TO FRIDAY 18 MAY 2018



Work in preparation for major construction of the new Anzac Station is continuing in the Domain Precinct.

#### Lighting Installation

**9pm-5am, Sunday 6 May to Friday, 11 May**

Following feedback from the community about temporary lighting in the Domain Precinct, we are bringing forward the installation of new street lighting on St Kilda Road. These works will involve the installation of lights on existing poles, and the erection of new light poles on Albert Road North.

These works will include:

- Use of a truck mounted crane, some hand tools and an elevated works platform to erect poles and install luminaries
- Works to install lights on existing poles will take place from 9pm to 5am each day from **Sunday 6 May to Friday 11 May**
- Works to erect new lighting poles on Albert Road North will take place from **9pm, Sunday 6 May to 5am, Monday 7 May**
- Works to install lights on existing poles will begin on Park Street, South Melbourne and the crews will progressively move up St Kilda Road over this time period
- These works need to occur at night when traffic volumes are low, and in some locations while trams are not running.

These works are expected to generate low levels of noise.

#### Tram completion works

**10pm-6pm, Sunday 6 May – Wednesday 9 May**

A number of minor completion works need to be carried out after-hours while trams are not running. These works have been scheduled to coincide with the lighting installation to minimise the amount of night works.

These works include:

- Profiling and asphaltting at the intersection of Park Street and St Kilda Road
- Installation of yellow tram kerbs on Park Street and north of the new tram platforms on St Kilda Road
- Bluestone kerb installation on Park Street
- Tram kerb patching in various locations along St Kilda Road between Albert Road and Bowen Crescent
- Bluestone tile and tactile installation for the new Park Street tram platforms

These works are expected to generate low levels of noise.



## Line marking

**10pm-6am, Tuesday 8 May to Friday, 18 May**

- Additional line marking on St Kilda Road between Albert Road and Bowen Crescent
- Green bike lane marking and red bus lane marking
- Water blasting for redundant line marking removal (**Wednesday 16 May**).

These works are expected to generate low levels of noise, with the exception of water blasting which will produce high level of noise.

## Concrete barrier installation

**8pm-6am, Sunday 6 May**

- Temporary concrete barrier placement between Bowen Crescent and Albert Road South north bound.

## Traffic changes





Please be aware that these works will also include the following traffic changes:


- Local Traffic only between Bowen Crescent and Albert Road South whilst temporary concrete barriers are put in place on **Sunday 6 May**. There may be some short delays and traffic management will be in place
- Closure of Albert Road North from **8pm Sunday 6 May to 2am, Monday 7 May**
- Local access will be maintained and traffic management will be in place
- Closure of the left turn from St Kilda Road into Park Street from **1am-5am, Monday 7 May** (please note that the left turn will be available for residents of the Hallmark Apartments to access their car park. Traffic controllers will be in place to enable the turn)
- Closure of access from Park Street onto St Kilda Road (both left and right turn) from **9pm, Sunday 6 May to 5am, Monday 7 May**
- Overnight closure of the left turn from Park Street to St Kilda Road from **10pm, Sunday 6 May to 6am, Monday 7 May**.
