



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SERVICE RELOCATION, PARKVILLE 15 MAY 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway to support construction of a new underground station in Parkville.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for this package of works, which includes the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

What we are doing

Service relocation

- Installing new telecommunication conduits on Royal Parade and Elizabeth Street, across Grattan Street
- Moving existing telecommunication services into new conduits.

Service relocation

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on Flemington Road and Grattan Street
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service (including in footpaths and roads).

What to be aware of

- Traffic management measures will ensure the safety of work crews, cyclists and pedestrians and maintain flow of traffic
- There will be some noise associated with this activity
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There is no planned disruption to essential services.

Service relocation

- The conduits will be installed by open cut trenching, consisting of excavating a trench and manually installing each piece of pipe, backfilling and reinstating the area
- There will be southbound lane closures on Royal Parade between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street and no left turn onto Grattan Street during the working hours outlined below (note lane closures will commence from 10am Monday to Friday). Please refer to signage in the area
- The southbound bicycle lane on Royal Parade between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street will be detoured to the pedestrian path during the working hours outlined below (note the bicycle lane will be closed from 10am Monday to Friday). Please refer to signage in the area
- The existing bus routes 505 and 546 on Royal Parade, between College Crescent and Grattan Street, will detour southbound along the centre carriage way, with temporary bus stops on the median strip.

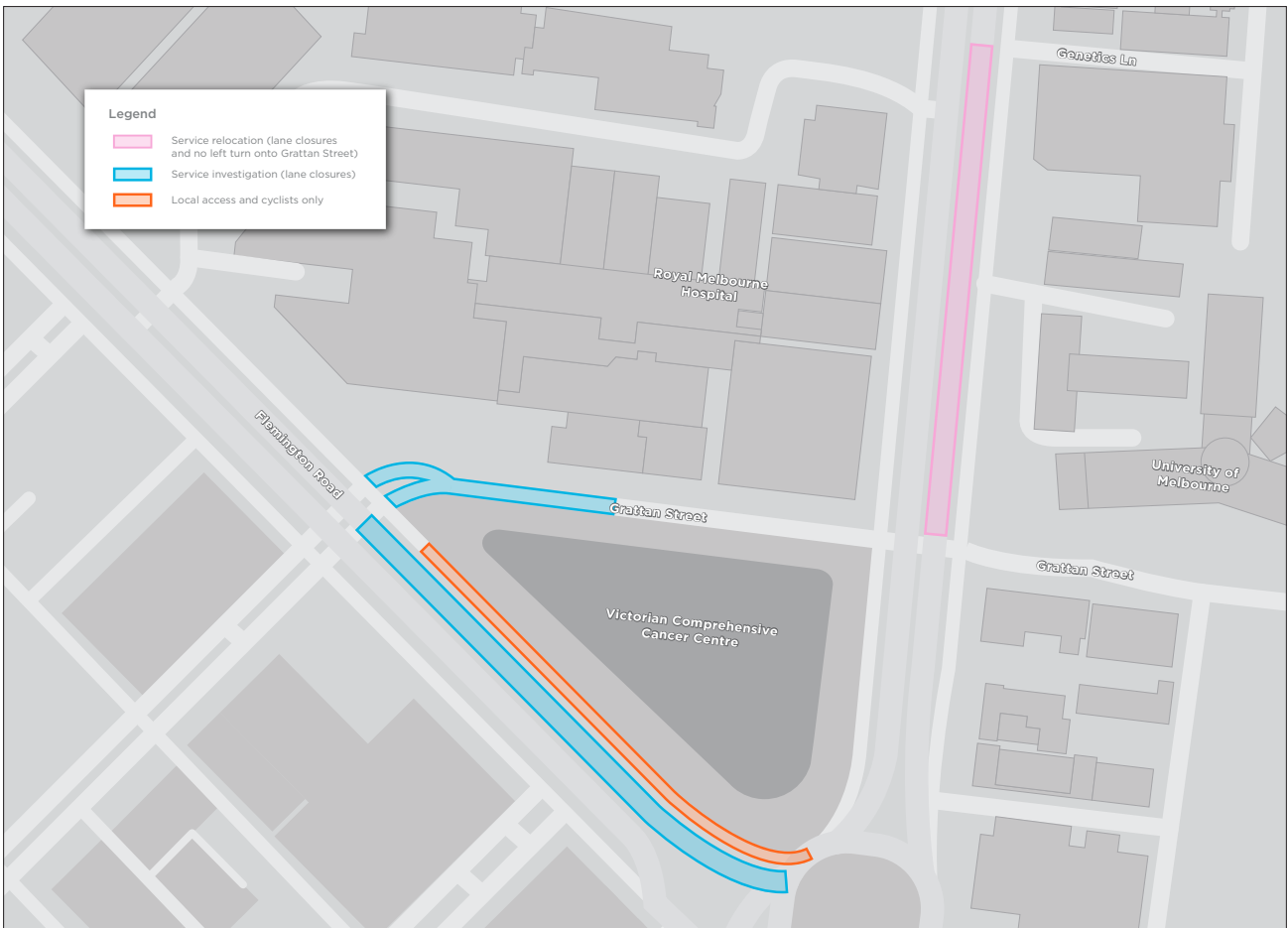
Service investigation

- There will be lane closures on Grattan Street between Flemington Road and Royal Parade from 7pm - 6am Monday to Sunday.
- There will be lane closures on Flemington Road between Grattan Street and Elizabeth Street from 7pm - 6am Monday to Sunday and from 10am - 3pm to complete saw cutting the road
- Please refer to signage in the area
- The location of NDD sites may vary depending on results of the investigation works

Service relocation (Royal Parade and Elizabeth Street)

From Monday 15 May to Saturday 20 May 2017

- 7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 1pm, Saturday

From Monday 22 May, until late-July 2017

- 7am - 8pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am - 7pm, Saturday and Sunday

Timing is staged as works progress from one location to the next. A notification will be provided prior to the next stage.

Service investigation (Flemington Road and Grattan Street)

From Monday 22 May, until mid-June 2017

- 6pm - 7am, Monday to Sunday
- 10am - 3pm, Monday to Friday


All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.
