



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### ENHANCING THE ROAD NETWORK, QUEENSBERRY STREET NIGHT WORKS 8 - MID JULY 2017

Changes to Queensberry Street - which are now underway - will allow traffic to flow more efficiently through the north of the city during construction of the Metro Tunnel.

As part of the works, median parking will be removed to allow Queensberry Street to be widened to two lanes of traffic in each direction between Rathdowne Street and Elizabeth Street.

John Holland has been appointed as the managing contractor for these works.

#### What we are doing

- A one week night-time lane closure of Queensberry Street between Bouverie Street and Peel Street from 8 July for road resurfacing and line marking works
- Works are being delivered at night outside of peak time to minimise impacts to traffic
- Detours will be in place to assist traffic to safely navigate the site during this time
- Activities to move the work site further along Queensberry Street - to between Swanston Street and Lygon Street - will continue during the day
- Barriers will be installed on Queensberry Street between Swanston Street and Lygon Street to create the next work location. This installation will take one week to complete, enabling the next stage of the Queensberry Street changes to continue

- Once the site has been moved to the new location, parking will be returned to the southern kerbside between Leicester Street and Bouverie Street.

#### What to be aware of

- Traffic management will be in place during construction to maintain the flow of traffic and ensure the safety of work crews and pedestrians
- Where road closures are required, detours will be in place, and access for residents and businesses will be maintained
- During the works, some kerbside parking will be temporarily removed along Queensberry Street to ensure adequate space to establish the work site in the centre median, while maintaining a bicycle lane and a traffic lane in each direction.

#### When

- 8am - 5pm, Sunday to Friday
- 6pm - 7am, Monday to Friday
- Night works will be required to safely undertake works in high-traffic areas, to ensure the safety of our work crews and the public
- Day works will involve moving the site as works progress.

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.

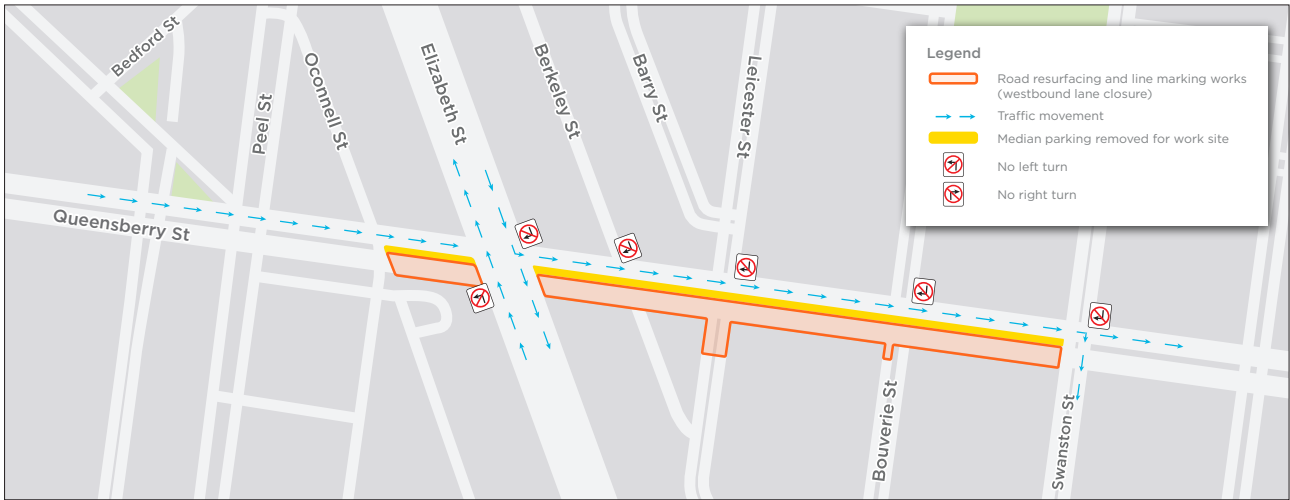
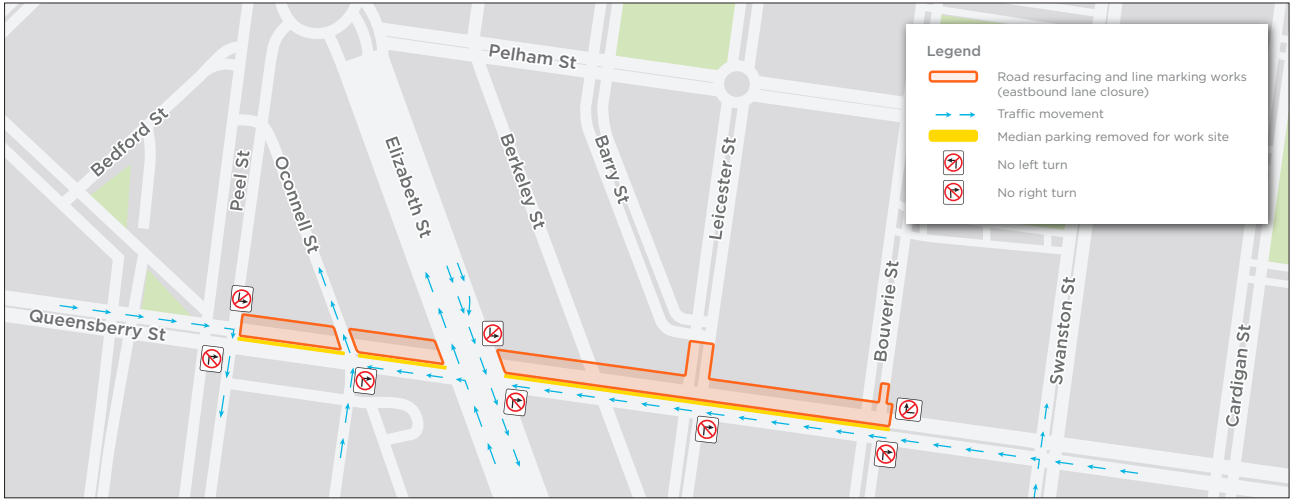
We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.
