








STATE LIBRARY STATION TIMELINE – EARLY WORKS



FRANKLIN STREET & A'BECKETT STREET SHAFT UPDATE

- 24 hour works ongoing at both shaft sites within the acoustic sheds
- Deliveries of props, beams and materials 24 hours a day being prioritised to occur in early evenings from remote locations
- Doors are being closed for all night works

GROUNDWATER MONITORING UPDATE

- Boreholes complete
- Water main relocation complete
- Boring works beneath Victoria Street from Bouverie to Therry streets to connect the west and eastbound boreholes on Victoria Street – underway
- Trenching to connect boreholes in Bouverie Street
 ongoing until early October, including weekend works
- Commissioning ground water monitoring system
 until December



	Flinders Street investigations	Collins Street investigations
When	10pm – 6am, Monday 24 - Thursday 27 September	10pm – 6am, Monday 1 - Thursday 4 October
Traffic changes	 Eastbound lane closure between Queen and Swanston Street 	Westbound lanes will be closed between Russel and Swanston Street
Pedestrian changers	Local access only for the northern footpath between Swanston and Degraves Street	Closure of the southern footpath between Swanston Street and Regent Place

GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATIONS

- Installing groundwater monitoring wells across the Town Hall Station precinct. This involves:
 - Setting up a temporary worksite, and using non-destructive digging and a drill rig to install a well
- Indicative start: October TBC
- Further information will be released once locations are confirmed.


SWANSTON STREET TREE REMOVAL





FEDERATION SQUARE CIVIL WORKS STAGING

From October, the **outer left hand turn westbound lane on Flinders Street will be closed** for up to four years and **civil works will be completed** on Flinders Street to **support construction** of the new Town Hall Station entrance at Federation Square.

This involves:

- Closure of one westbound lane on Flinders Street
- Concrete barrier construction
- Implementing new signal changes
- Kerb alignment works

When: 10pm – 5am

Indicative timing: 3 October – Late November 2018

Works are required to be completed at night to minimise impacts to Flinders Street traffic and tram network.



STAGE ONE

Stage 1: approximately 1 week

 Removing the median strip using an excavator, jackhammer and saw cut between the through lane and the westbound tram lines






STAGE TWO

Stage 2: approximately 2 nights

- Setting up temporary barriers
- Realigning the westbound inner lefthand turn lane and through lane and signal changes





STAGE THREE

Stage 3: approximately 3 weeks

 Construction of a concrete barrier using an excavator, jackhammer and saw cut between the two westbound left-hand turning lanes






STAGE FOUR

Stage 4: approximately 1 week

- Changing the kerb using an excavator, jackhammer and saw cut
- Realigning the pedestrian crossover on the corner of Federation Square at the Flinders Street and Swanston Street intersection
- Relocating tram poles on Flinders Street, adjacent to the Young and Jackson Hotel




CBD SOUTH TRUCK ROUTES

- Truck staging area proposed to be located off Batman Avenue (refer to indicative yellow zone on map)






CITY SQUARE – STAGE 1 PRIMARY ROUTES





GROUNDWATER MONITORING

- Ongoing groundwater monitoring on Victoria Street, Therry Street, Bouverie Street, and Franklin Street
- Wells are located on footpaths and roads
- Some out of hours work required due to required lane closures
- Testing occurs periodically (monthly, quarterly etc)










MODELLING THE IMPACTS

- CYP has undertaken detailed traffic modelling to inform the traffic management.
- Modelling showing up to 4 minute delays on Flinders Street. Expecting initial delays up to 15 minutes.
- Helped to understand the behaviour of motorists using the Flinders Street area i.e. origins / destinations

INFLUENCING TRAVEL BEHAVIOUR

Aim to influence behaviour of motorists by providing information to help them make informed travel decisions.

- Trying a different route to find the quickest way
 - Comparison of journey times from the CBD to key locations i.e. St Kilda Junction, West Gate Freeway
- Leaving earlier or later to avoid the busiest times on road
 - Comparison of vehicles volumes on key roads during the day i.e. Flinders Street
- Considering other transport options
 - Comparison of journey times on different modes using i.e. PTV Journey Planner, Google Maps



TARGETED ENGAGEMENT

1. Workplaces in the CBD and Southbank


- Where commuting motorists begin or end their trips in weekday periods.
- State Government, ANZ, Bupa, Ernst & Young, AusPost, Telstra etc

2. Entertainment and Tourism Venues

- Where irregular motorists visit during weekdays and weekends
- ACMI, NGV inc. Ian Potter, Arts Centre, The Forum etc

3. Parking Facilities

 Used by regular and irregular motorists during weekdays and weekends
