OUT OF HOURS LINE MARKING WORKS, PARKVILLE PRECINCT SATURDAY 4 AND SUNDAY 5 MAY 2019

Please be advised out of hours works are required for line marking to support changed traffic movements at the intersection of Pelham and Berkeley streets and update the roundabout at the corner of Grattan and Leicester streets.

What we are doing

Pelham and Berkeley Street intersection

- Line marking works at the intersection of Berkeley and Pelham streets to provide priority to the east- west traffic movement on Pelham Street (see diagram)
- Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times with diversions in place
- Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles safely around the works area.

Grattan and Leicester Street roundabout

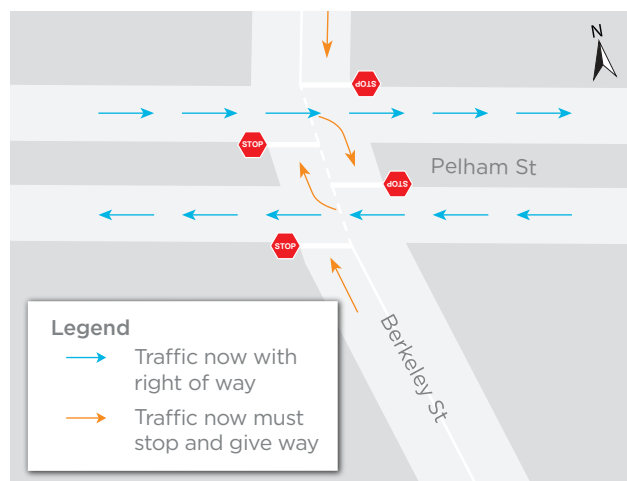
- Line marking works to update the roundabout at the corner of Grattan and Leicester streets
- During works, Leicester Street will be closed between Pelham and Grattan streets
- Access for pedestrians and cyclists, including to residential properties, will be maintained at all times
- Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles safely around the works area.

When

- 10pm to 5am, Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 May 2019.

What to be aware of





- These works are required out of hours to minimise impacts to traffic and bus services
- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise.
