# GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATIONS AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS ON GREVILLE, UNION, GREEN AND PORTER STREETS

**MONDAY 20 MAY TO MONDAY 10 JUNE 2019**

As part of the Metro Tunnel project, major works will be carried out on the Sandringham line throughout May and June. To allow the project to access the rail corridor and to complete works safely, traffic management will be in place on Greville, Union, Green and Porter streets while we complete these important works.

### What we are doing

#### Rail corridor access and equipment stockpile area

- Equipment will be driven into the rail corridor during the day and then ferried to the work site at the South Yarra Siding Reserve, where we are undertaking 24/7 works
- Crushed rock, cable conduit and equipment will be stockpiled along the corridor for use during the works.

#### Service Investigations

- Geotechnical testing of the existing ground conditions using a small drill
- The drill will be set up within the rail corridor near Union and Greville streets
- The drill will take multiple samples of the ground conditions, which will help inform our detailed design going forward.

#### Traffic management

- Single lane closures will be in place on Greville, Union, Green and Porter streets, traffic management will assist vehicles moving throughout the area
- Pedestrian detours will also be in place during this time. Signage will be in place to assist people travelling in the area.

### When

- Monday, 20 May to Monday, 10 June
- Monday to Sunday
- 7am to 7pm.

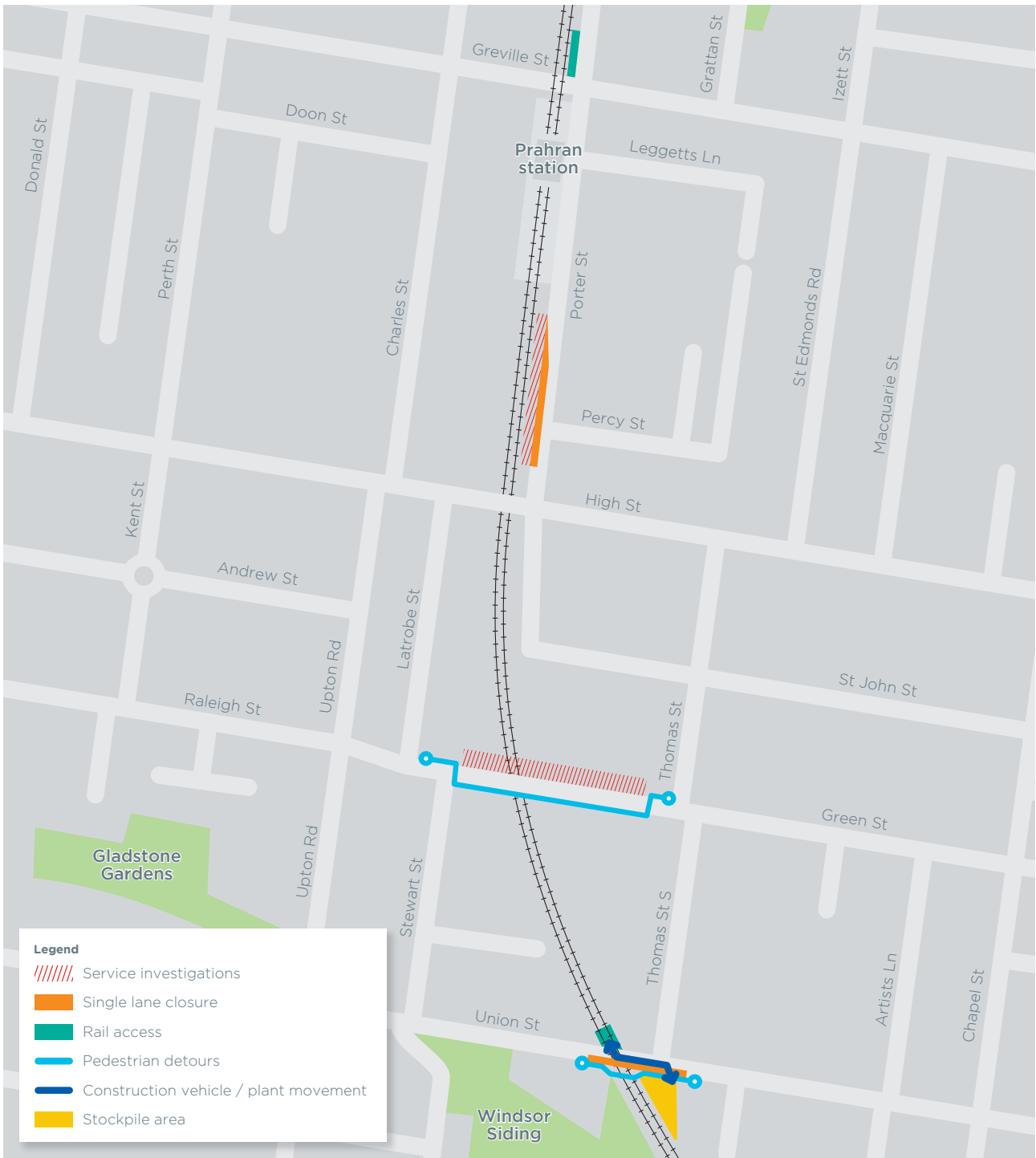
### What to be aware of

#### Noise

- Drilling works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with periods of high-level noise
- Rail access and stockpiling activities are expected to generate low levels of noise.

#### Road closures and pedestrian detours

- There will be ongoing traffic management during this time.
