WORKS NOTIFICATION

NIGHTWORKS AND PARKING REMOVAL FOR CABLE AND POWER UPGRADES - PALFREYMAN STREET AND RAILWAY PLACE **WEDNESDAY 12 TO WEDNESDAY 19 JUNE 2019**

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will be installing and upgrading cable and power supplies along the rail corridor near Palfreyman Street and Railway Place. These upgrades will help provide power to the new train lines once complete. Some of these works will be undertaken over a 24/7 period and will require parking removal and a road closure.

What we are doing

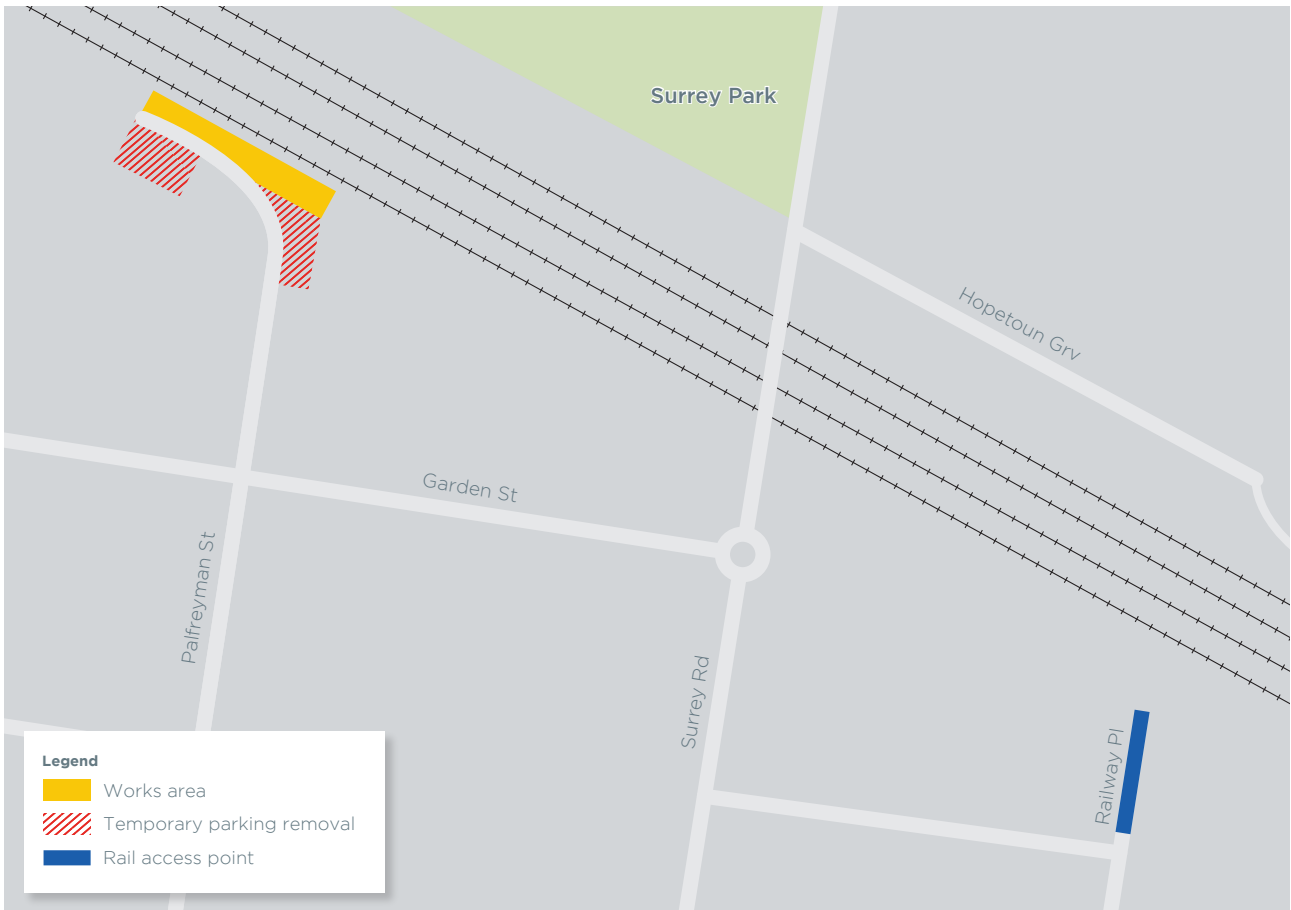
- Installation of temporary rail access pads at Palfreyman Street and Railway Place
- Excavation, drilling and digging of the new cable route
- Laying down and dragging new cables and casing, and drilling new structural supports into the ground
- Works will involve a small work crew with an excavator, drill and hand tools
- Railway Place will also be used as a rail access point during this time.

When

- Works will take place between Monday and Friday from 7am to 6pm
- There will be 24/7 works from 6pm Friday 14 to 7am Monday 17 June
- Palfreyman Place will be used as a rail access point 24/7 from 6pm Friday 14 to 7am Monday 17 June.




What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate periods of medium level noise with periods of high level noise as we drill into the ground
- Directional lighting will be in place during this time, for worker safety. We will position lights so they face away from residential properties, where possible
- Some parking on Palfreyman Street will be temporary closed from 7am Wednesday 12 to 6pm Wednesday 19 June. See map overleaf for details.
