



WORKS NOTIFICATION

24/7 WORKS FROM TOORAK ROAD TO HAWKSburn STATION

FRIDAY 8 TO MONDAY 11 NOVEMBER

In mid-November, 24/7 works will take place within the rail corridor between Toorak Road and Hawksburn station. Works will involve service investigations and the installation of signal foundations, overhead wires and cables along the rail corridor.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD), to locate and expose underground services and cables
- NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Excavation and concrete pouring to install foundations for overhead structures
- Trenching works for underground conduit installation
- Running cables through new conduits and overhead structures.

When

- Friday 8 to Monday 11 November
- 24/7 works, beginning after the last passenger service on Friday evening and finishing before the first passenger service on Monday morning
- These works are required to take place while trains are being rerouted to ensure the safety of our workers.

Traffic impacts

During this time, 24/7 construction vehicle access to the rail corridor via the following locations will be required:

- White Street, Cremorne
- Palfreyman Street, South Yarra.

Some temporary parking removal will also be required during this time. Additional notification will be provided to directly affected residents and businesses.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with some periods of high-level noise while excavation and trenching activities are being completed
- These works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from homes
- Additional truck movements will be required as soil is removed from the rail corridor.
