OUT OF HOURS WORKS TOWER CRANE INSTALLATION, FLINDERS QUARTER DECEMBER 2019

Major construction is continuing in the CBD at the site of the future Town Hall Station. Further to the Town Hall Station construction notification distributed earlier this month, we wish to remind you that there will be works occurring outside of normal construction hours throughout December to deliver and install a tower crane.

What we are doing

- Mobilising a crane which will be used to construct the tower crane segments
- Constructing a tower crane within the Flinders Quarter site
- Regular deliveries for the tower crane via the Swanston and Flinders Street driveways
- The use of a crane, heavy vehicles, light towers and hand tools.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise. Noisier works will be completed earlier in the shift where possible
- These works and deliveries are required to take place at night to minimise traffic and tram disruption and for the safety of the public and our workers
- The tower crane delivery schedule is subject to change. Impacted residents will be notified with more information prior.

When

Oversized deliveries

- 8pm to 12am, between Thursday 5 and Friday 6 December

- 5am to 7am, Saturday 7 December.

Tower crane construction

- 6pm to 8pm, Friday 6 December
- 7am to 6:30pm, Saturday 7 December
- 8am to 4pm, Sunday 8 December
- 1am to 5am, Tuesday 10 December.



- The tower crane will be located in the north-west side of the Flinders Quarter site and will be in place for approximately three years
- The arm of the tower crane is known as the jib
- The jib is nearly 60 metres long but operates at an angle, preventing any movements over adjacent properties
- The jib will rotate when the tower crane is not in use. This movement is known as weather vaning
- All lifts using the tower crane will occur from within the Flinders Quarter site.
