SITE ESTABLISHMENT MALVERN STATION

FRIDAY 13 DECEMBER TO EARLY FEBRUARY 2020

As part of the ongoing Metro Tunnel works in South Yarra, the project will temporarily use the car park located near Malvern station as storage space for materials and equipment. This area will also be used as a rail access point to support construction of the eastern tunnel entrance throughout January.

What we are doing

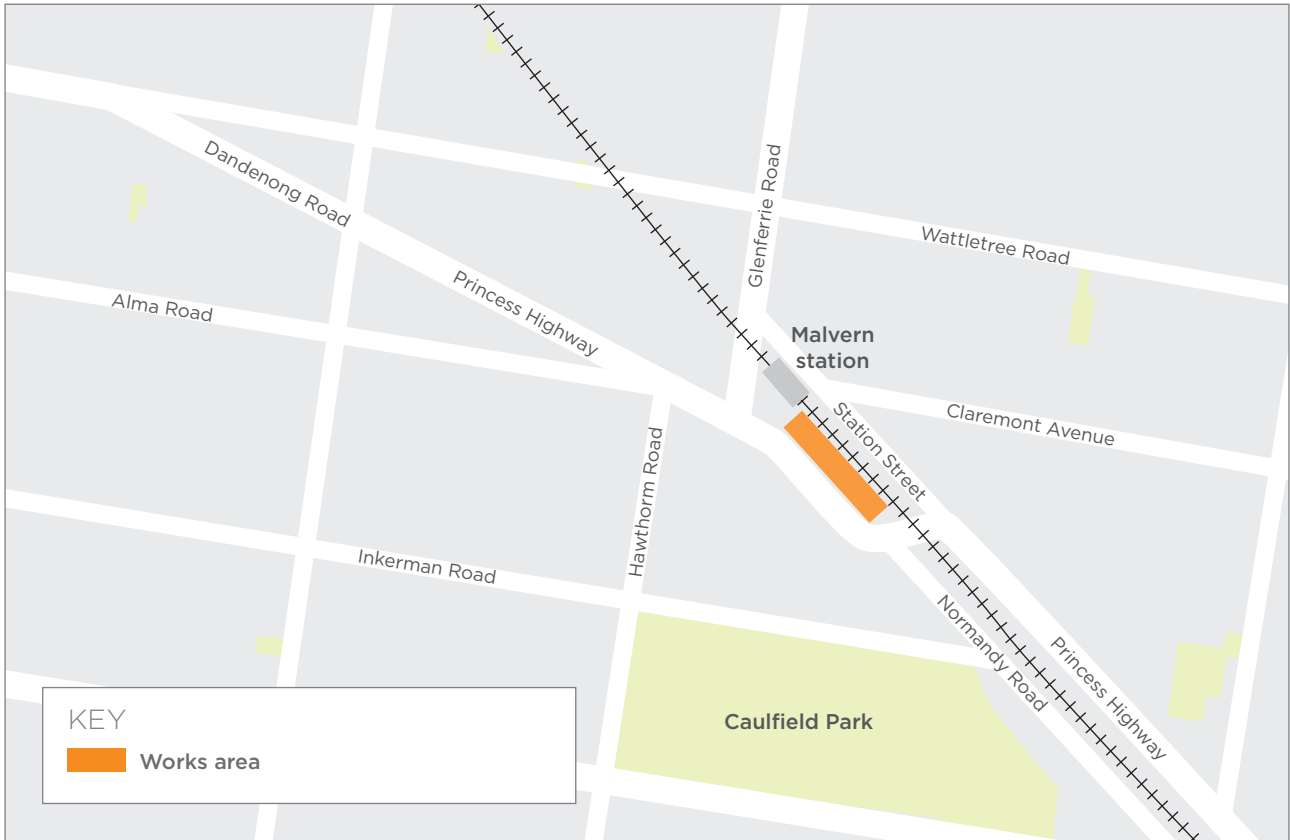
- Delivering essential equipment and materials to and from the site
- Using the site to access the rail corridor. Work crews will move equipment along the rail corridor and into the construction area between Hawksburn station and South Yarra Siding Reserve.

When

- From Friday 13 December to February 2020
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays
- In January, the site will be accessed 24/7 as we complete round the clock works while trains aren't running. More information will be provided closer to the date.

What to be aware of

- Additional truck movements will be required as materials are delivered to and from site
- Some directional lightening will be required during periods of 24/7 works to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from homes
- We expect there to be low to medium levels of noise while we are in the area.
