# TUNNEL BORING MACHINE DELIVERIES, DOMAIN PRECINCT 2020

Assembly of the tunnel boring machines is underway in Domain with pieces being delivered overnight in the months ahead.

### What we are doing

- The tunnel boring machines (TBMs) arrive to the future Anzac station in pieces and are then assembled on site
- TBMs are classed as oversized deliveries
- Oversized deliveries to site must take place in the early morning to minimise impact on the road and tram networks
- Oversized deliveries will cause some periods of noise. All delivery trucks and equipment will be fitted with reversing white noise alarms and will not be unloaded outside of the acoustic shed until after 7am (unless further notification has been given).

### When

- 1am to 5am, as scheduled, throughout 2020

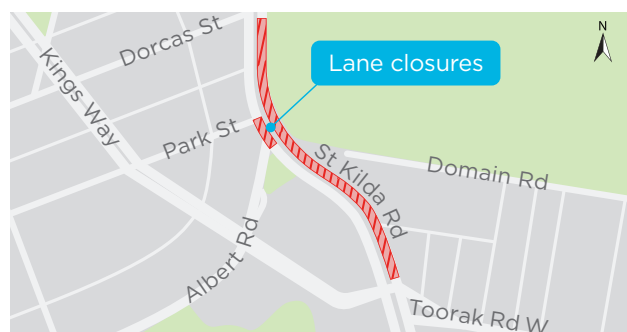

### What to be aware of

- St Kilda Road will be partially closed in both directions between 1am and 5am, as shown on the map below, to facilitate oversized deliveries
- Closed southbound from Dorcas Street to Toorak Road West
- Closed northbound from Albert Road North to Park Street
- During these deliveries there will be a detour in place via Kings Way. Local access along St Kilda Road will be maintained.
