

Works Notification

Out of hours rail works

Rail corridor works between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

24-hours - 7pm Friday 26 to 3am Monday 29 March 2021

Normal construction hours - Monday 29 March to Friday 30 April 2021

As part of works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing eastern corridor rail lines, we are undertaking works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, including one weekend of 24-hour works while trains are redirected.

What we are doing

Maintenance works

- Maintenance works on previously installed service pits and underground services, including relocating signalling assets within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) is required to locate and expose underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, an NDD truck, a hi-rail crane, a hi-rail excavator and crews with hand tools.

Relocatable equipment building (REB) works

- As previously notified, works to construct the REB at Toorak station will continue during normal construction hours until Friday 9 April
- Preparation works will also be undertaken for a new REB at Railway Place
- Works will include, earthworks to strengthen the ground, installing fences, retaining walls, new drainage, cable conduits, signalling and services infrastructure, and NDD works to investigate ground conditions
- These works will require the use of an excavator, an NDD truck, a dumper truck, a concrete truck, construction vehicles, trenching equipment and crews with hand tools
- Further information about works to install the REB will be provided closer to the building delivery date.

Cable conduit installation

- Conduits hold cables that run next to rail lines throughout the rail corridor
- Works to install new conduits will involve trenching into the ground
- NDD is required to locate and safely expose any existing underground services
- Works will require the use of excavators, an NDD truck and crews with hand tools.

When

Rail corridor works (24-hours)

- 7pm Friday 26 to 3am Monday 29 March.

REB works

- 24-hour works will take place from 7pm Friday 26 to 3am Monday 29 March

Railway Place

- Works will continue to progress during normal construction hours from Monday 29 March to Friday 30 April to Friday 30 April, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

Parking removal on Osment Street

- Thursday 25 March to Monday 29 March.

Parking removal on Wilson Street

- 26 March to Friday 30 April.

What to be aware of

Rail corridor works (24-hours)

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled to take place during the day
- Additional truck movements will be required during the out of hours works, as materials are delivered to work sites from our rail access points at, Osment Street, the carpark near Malvern station, Railway Place and Wilson Street
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.

Traffic management and parking removal

- Traffic management will be in place along, Osment Street, and the intersection between Wilson Street

and Railway Place while we complete works

- Five parking spaces along Wilson and Osment streets will be temporarily unavailable to accommodate additional space as delivery trucks manoeuvre safely into site
- Local access to properties on Wilson and Osment streets will maintained during these time.
