

Works Notification

Extended construction works schedule Caulfield station

Wednesday 16 to Friday 18 June 2021

Further to the works notification in late May, we wish to advise preparation works to install the relocatable equipment building (REB) at Caulfield station will be extended until Friday 18 June due to challenging wet weather.

What we are doing

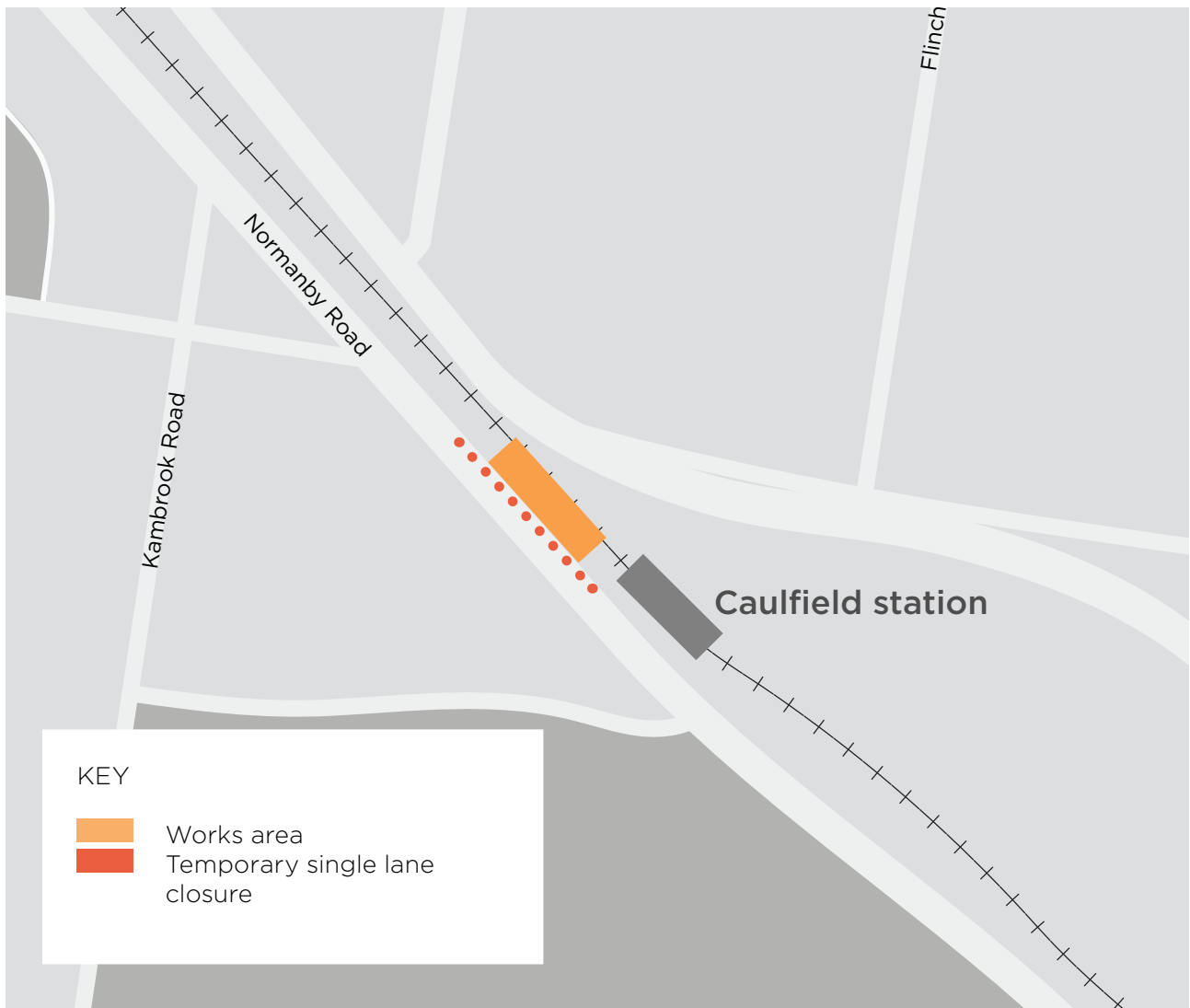
- Installing building foundations, retaining walls, new drainage, cable conduits, signalling and service pits
- Works will involve the use of an excavator, concrete trucks, crews with hand tools and non-destructive digging to locate any existing underground services and investigate ground conditions
- the REB will be built offsite and delivered to the site pre-constructed
- Further information about works to deliver and install the building will be provided closer to the date.

When

- As previously notified, works will be ongoing until Friday 11 June and will continue from Wednesday 16 to Friday 18 June
- 7am to 6pm.

What you should be aware of

- Works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, a single lane along Normanby Road will be temporarily unavailable during these times
- Traffic management will be in place along Normanby Road to facilitate local traffic.



Health and safety

Metro Tunnel works are progressing safely under the current circuit breaker coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions in Victoria.

Construction is an authorised industry and COVIDSafe Plans are in place on all our project sites.

The health and safety of our workforce and community is our top priority.
