

Works Notification

Reminder: Offset parking decommissioning works Hobsons Road, Kensington

July 2021

Following the partial reopening of Childers Street there will be an increase in construction activity on the corner of Hobsons and Kensington roads to decommission the offset parking.

What we are doing

- Demolishing remaining existing pavement and kerb using excavators and jackhammers
- Concrete and earth works to reinstate the area.

When

- Ongoing until the end of July
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks when breaking back concrete
- Low levels of vibration may be felt during compaction works

- Traffic management will be required when removing the current crossover and reinstating the new kerb along Hobsons Road. Some parking along Hobsons Road will be occupied in order to maintain two way traffic.
