



WORKS NOTIFICATION

FLINDERS STREET WORKS TOWN HALL STATION CONSTRUCTION **3 OCTOBER – MID NOVEMBER**

Major construction of the Metro Tunnel and the new Town Hall Station is underway. The next phase of construction involves works on Flinders Street to prepare for the four year closure of the westbound outer left turn lane from the night of Tuesday 9 October.

From early October, works will begin on Flinders Street, between Russell Street and Elizabeth Street, and on Swanston Street. These works will be carried out at night and in stages, each with different traffic impacts.

What we are doing

Flinders Street works will occur in four stages:

Wednesday 3 to Monday 8 October for five nights

- Removing the median strip between the westbound through lane and the westbound tram lines using an excavator, jackhammer and road saw.

Tuesday 9 October for one night

- Installing temporary barriers between the two left hand turn westbound lanes to delineate the Federation Square site loading bay
- Realigning the westbound inner left-hand turn lane and through lane
- Adjusting signals at the Swanston Street intersection
- Closing the outer westbound left-hand turning lane for up to four years.

Wednesday 10 October for up to three weeks

- Installing a footing for concrete barriers between the two westbound left-hand turning lanes using an excavator, jackhammer and road saw.

From Wednesday 31 October for up to one week

- Realigning the kerb and pedestrian crossover, including drainage modification works, on the south-east corner of the Swanston Street intersection using an excavator, jackhammer and road saw
- Tram pole relocation works on Flinders Street, adjacent to Federation Square, in November for up to two nights.


When

- All works will be carried out from 10pm -5am, Sunday to Thursday, from Wednesday 3 October for up to six weeks
- These works will occur at night to minimise impacts to traffic and the tram network on Flinders Street
- Works will not occur on Friday and Saturday nights.

What to be aware of

- Works are weather dependant. If works cannot be completed due to weather, they will be undertaken on the next suitable night
- There will be traffic impacts at varying locations in the area, depending on the type of works. Please look out for electronic signs for information on how to get around safely.

3-8 October works and 10 October works for up to three weeks

Traffic changes

- These works will not impact tram services along Flinders and Swanston Street
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas
- Access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times.

Wednesday 3 to Monday 8 October

- The westbound through lane and tram line will be closed on Flinders Street, adjacent to Federation Square. Through and left turning traffic movements will be maintained
- Works on the tram line will commence after the trams have finished operating at 1am.


Tuesday 9 October for one night

- Westbound lanes on Flinders Street between Russell Street and Swanston Street will be closed
- Southbound lanes on Swanston Street will be also be closed between Flinders Lane and Flinders Street, with detours via Russell, Collins, Queens, Flinders streets, and Kings Way to St Kilda Road
- A single lane closure on Flinders Street eastbound, adjacent to Young & Jackson will also be in place. One Swanston Street northbound lane, adjacent to Flinders Street Station, will also be closed.


From 10pm on Tuesday 9 October for up to four years

- The outer left hand turn lane westbound on Flinders Street, adjacent to Federation Square, will be closed for up to four years.

9 October works for one night and November works for up to two nights



31 October works for up to one week



Wednesday 10 October for up to three weeks

- Both westbound left turn lanes on Flinders Street will be closed overnight. Through and left turning traffic movements will be maintained from the middle westbound through lane.

Wednesday 31 October for up to one week

- Flinders Street westbound lanes and Swanston Street southbound will be closed to traffic between Russell Street and Swanston Street.

From November for up to two nights

- To facilitate tram relocation works, all westbound lanes on Flinders Street between Russell Street and Swanston Street will be closed. Southbound lanes on Swanston Street will be closed between Flinders Lane and Flinders Street. The detour route is via Russell, Collins, Queens, Flinders streets, and King Ways to St Kilda Road. A single lane closure on Flinders Street eastbound adjacent to Young and Jackson will also be in place. One Swanston Street northbound lane, adjacent to Flinders Street Station, will also be closed.

Plan ahead for traffic changes

- Allow extra time if travelling through areas impacted by works
- Check live traffic times before you leave at traffic.vicroads.vic.gov.au
- Find a faster route with real-time navigation.

Noise and equipment

- These works will generate medium to high levels of noise. Noise will be kept to a minimum where possible
- Construction equipment will include excavators, generators, non-destructive drilling trucks, line-marking machines, saw cutting equipment, jackhammers, heavy vehicles, general site vehicles, and hand tools (mechanical and non-mechanical)
- Every effort will be made to mitigate noise impacts to residents and businesses in the area.
