LA TROBE STREET TRAFFIC CHANGES JULY - AUGUST 2020

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new State Library Station at the northern end of Swanston Street in the CBD.

The eastbound lane on La Trobe Street will be closed between Elizabeth and Swanston streets during standard construction hours from Monday 27 July to Wednesday 19 August 2020.

The closures will support the construction of the underground passenger connection between Melbourne Central Station and the future State Library Station.

What we are doing

- Temporarily closing the eastbound lane on La Trobe Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets
- Removing and delivering materials to the La Trobe Street site using trucks.


What to be aware of

- There will be no through access for motorists or cyclists to Swanston Street travelling eastbound during these closures (refer to map for detour)
- The northern footpath on La Trobe Street will remain closed adjacent to the La Trobe Street site
- Pedestrian access to the tram stop on La Trobe Street will be maintained at all times
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas
- Access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times.


When
