Concrete testing

Collins Street

November 2020

Large volumes of concrete are required for the construction of the new Town Hall Station. From Thursday 5 November, concrete trucks will intermittently park in the loading bay on Collins Street, adjacent to the City Square site to enable concrete testing to take place.

What we are doing

- Parking concrete trucks in the loading bay on Collins Street (refer to map)
- Taking a sample from the concrete truck into the acoustic shed for testing
- Concrete testing will take up to 30 minutes to complete
- Once concrete testing has taken place the concrete truck will enter the City Square acoustic shed via the Collins Street driveway
- The concrete trucks are expected to generate low levels of noise.


What to be aware of

- Concrete trucks will park in the loading bay on Collins Street for up to 30 minutes to enable concrete testing to take place
- The concrete truck engine and agitator will need to remain running while concrete testing takes place to prevent the concrete from setting
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work area
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times
- This arrangement is expected to be in place for approximately one year.

When

Concrete testing:

7am to 10pm, Monday to Fridays, and
7am to 10pm Saturdays (as required),
from Thursday 5 November 2020.
