

# Works Notification

## Investigative works between Clayton and Springvale Stations

**10 December to 22 December 2020**

As part of the Metro Tunnel project, investigative works are starting on the Pakenham/Cranbourne line between Clayton and Springvale stations to prepare for the installation of High Capacity Signalling equipment and technology.

To identify the location of underground services and analyse ground conditions within the rail corridor, non-destructive digging and bore hole drilling is required at various locations along the rail line in December.

### About High Capacity Signalling

The Metro Tunnel will free up space in the City Loop to run more trains to and from the suburbs by taking our busiest train lines through a new tunnel under the city. Next-generation High Capacity Signalling technology will be installed to deliver more trains, more often during peak times. This technology will revolutionise Melbourne's train network as we move towards a reliable 'turn-up-and-go' network similar to other cities such as London, Singapore and Hong Kong.

To visualise how High Capacity Signalling works, imagine driving on a freeway. Adaptive cruise control adjusts the vehicle speed according to the distance from the car ahead to help the driver travel more safely. Under the control of train drivers, High Capacity Signalling works in a similar way by communicating wirelessly between trains and a control centre.

### What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging
- Geotechnical drilling.


#### Day works:

### What you should be aware of

- Works will require the use of machinery including a non-destructive digging truck and geotechnical drill truck
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Traffic management will be in place as required to control vehicle movements and any impacts to pedestrians and shared user path access.
