**Temporary partial road closure
Inverness Avenue, Armadale**

7am Saturday 19 to 7pm Sunday 20 June 2021



Works to install overhead structure foundations within the rail corridor.

Further to the 24-hour rail works from Friday 18 to Monday 21 June between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, there will be additional works to install overhead structure foundations. A section of road between 19 Inverness Avenue and Inverness Avenue Park will be temporarily unavailable while the works take place, from **7am Saturday 19 to 7pm Sunday 20 June**.

A concrete pump will be set up north of Inverness Avenue while works are being undertaken within the rail corridor. As notified, works within the rail corridor will include piling, pouring concrete, non-destructive digging to locate underground assets without damaging them and crews with hand tools.

Additional truck movements will be required along Inverness Avenue and Wattleree Road, as concrete is delivered to site. Traffic management will be in place to safely facilitate local traffic. Vehicle access to local residential properties along Inverness Avenue will be maintained during this time.

Works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise while we undertake works within the rail corridor.

Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties.
