

Works Notification

24-hour rail works and temporary parking closure Cheel Street, Armadale

October 2021

Further to the previously notified 24-hour works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, parking along Cheel Street will be temporarily unavailable to assist works within the rail corridor.

What we are doing

- Constructing overhead structure foundations, installing overhead structures, signalling cable, rail assets, retaining walls, underground cable services and conduits within the rail corridor
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) is required to locate and expose underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, an NDD truck, cranes, excavators, concrete pumps and crews with hand tools
- Establishing a temporary site shed on some on-street parking along Luxton Road to provide essential worker amenities while we complete works.

When

24-hour rail works

- 8pm Friday 22 October to 3am Monday 25 October
- 8pm Friday 29 October to 9pm Sunday 31 October.

Temporary lane closure on Cheel Street

- 6pm Friday 22 October to 7am Monday 25 October
- 6pm Friday 29 October to 9pm Sunday 31 October.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- Some parking along Cheel Street will be temporarily unavailable while works are being undertaken
- Traffic management will be in place to facilitate local vehicles entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.

Health and safety

Works safely resumed from 5 October on the Metro Tunnel with COVID-Safe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.


Strict processes are in place to check and record the vaccination status of workers entering construction sites.
