WORKS NOTIFICATION

OVERNIGHT CONCRETE WORKS – SOUTH YARRA SIDING RESERVE **WEDNESDAY 7 AUGUST TO FRIDAY 9 AUGUST**

Recently, residents were informed about extended hours for ongoing steel tying and fixing works. As part of these works, we notified residents about a 6am start for a continuous concrete pour.

Due to the availability of the specific concrete in use and the amount that needs to be installed, the pour schedule has changed and will now occur overnight from 7pm to 7am. The continuous pour is required for the structural integrity of the new roof slab for the tunnel entrance.

What we are doing

- Pouring concrete over reinforced steel, creating a section of the new tunnel roof slab
- Smoothing and levelling the concrete surface
- These works will involve the use of a concrete pump and hand tools.

When

- One night shift only between Wednesday 7 and Friday 9 August. Adjacent residents will be notified when the shift date has been confirmed
- 7pm to 7am
- Please note there will be two additional pours in late August, further notification will be provided closer to the date.





What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with some high level noise when the concrete pump is in operation
- Directional lighting will also be in place. We will ensure this is pointed away from residential properties where possible
- Additional truck movements as concrete trucks arrive and depart from site.
