

## Monthly construction update

### Sunbury Line works

August 2019

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, Rail Projects Victoria will be extending station platforms as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade

These works will allow High Capacity Metro Trains to operate on the network and allow for 113,000 extra passengers to travel in peak periods per week.

To enable the new, longer trains to run on the Sunbury Line, platforms will be extended at the following stations:

- Sunshine
- West Footscray
- Middle Footscray
- Footscray

Wheelchair boarding platforms will also be installed at these stations to assist commuters with mobility issues to get on and off trains.

Before construction can begin to extend the platforms, works are required to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of any underground services.

#### When are we working?



##### Normal construction hours

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday  
7am to 1pm, Saturdays



##### Out of hours

Some works are required to take place out of normal construction hours.



##### 24 hours

24-hour works are sometimes required during peak construction activities.

# Works in your area

## Site investigations and preparatory works

### Sunshine Station

11pm, Friday 16 August to  
4am, Monday 19 August



- Non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks will operate adjacent to the rail corridor at Sunshine Station on the Station Place side to investigate the location of underground services
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise and vibration.

### Tottenham Station

11pm, Friday 16 August to  
4am, Monday 19 August



- Non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks will operate within the rail corridor, entering from Sunshine Road to investigate the location of underground services
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise and vibration.

### Middle Footscray Station

11pm, Friday 16 August to  
4am, Monday 19 August



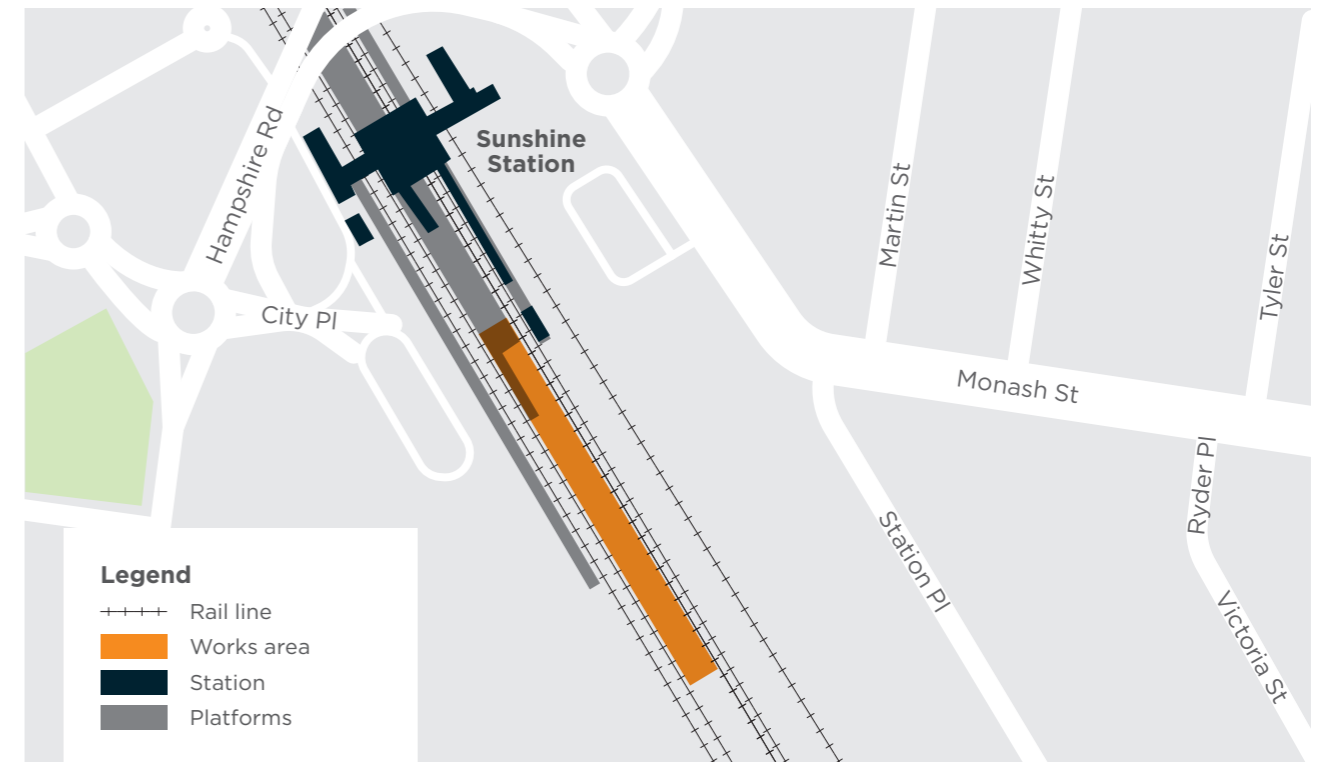
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks will operate within the rail corridor, entering from Buckley Street to investigate the location of underground services
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise and vibration.

### Footscray Station

8pm, Thursday 15 August to  
4am, Monday 19 August

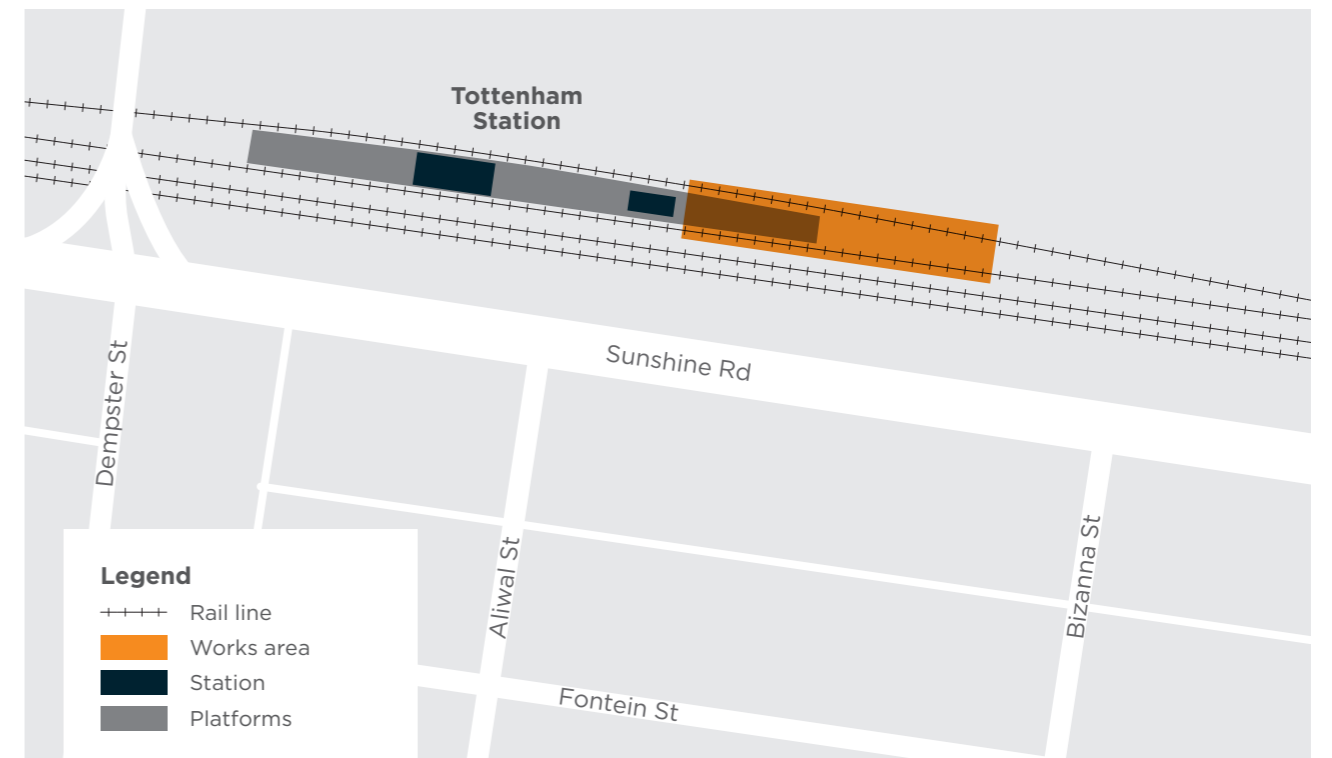


- To investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of any underground services, non-destructive digging trucks will operate within the rail corridor, entering from Leunig Place
- Works to construct a bored pile that will form the foundation of the extended platform
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise and vibration
- A concrete pump will be set up on the pedestrian footpath on Irving Street adjacent to the rail corridor. During these works the footpath will be closed and pedestrian detours in place
- The westbound lane on Irving Street will also be narrowed for the duration of these works to allow concrete trucks to park adjacent to the rail corridor.

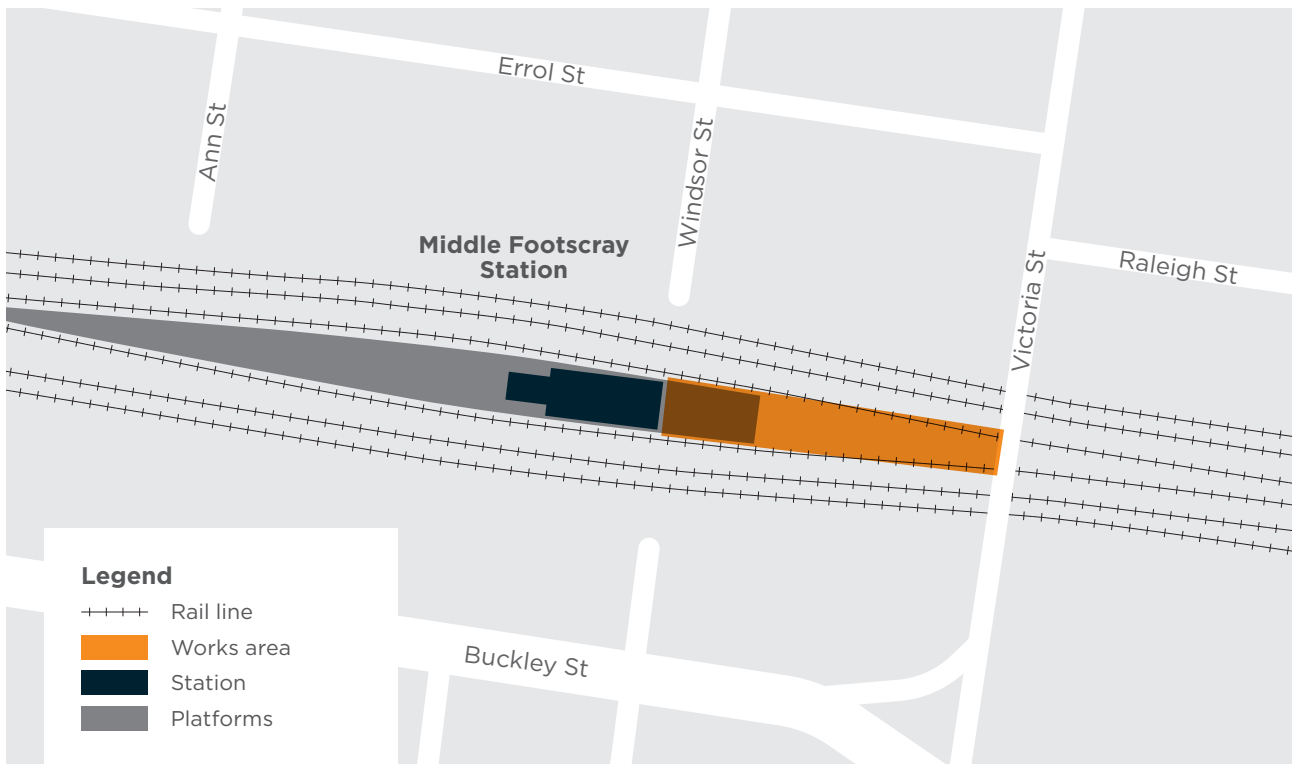
## Traffic and transport impacts

- To ensure the safety of the general public and our workers, some of these activities can only be conducted when trains are not operating
- Construction vehicles, including trucks, will be travelling on local roads to access the rail corridor
- Traffic controllers will be present at all times to assist construction vehicle access, pedestrians and cyclist movements around construction sites.

## Travel changes

To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line from **8.30pm to last service on Thursday 15 August**, and from **12.30am Saturday 17 August to the last service on Sunday 18 August**.
