
LA TROBE STREET WORKS UPDATE NOVEMBER - DECEMBER 2019

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new State Library Station at the northern end of Swanston Street in the CBD.

Further to the State Library Construction Update distributed in early-November, we wish to advise that works to remove the temporary shaft are continuing until late-December.

What we are doing

- Constructing a reinforced concrete slab, and installing a structural bulkhead and rock anchors within the temporary shaft
- Demobilising the scrubber (ventilation system) components and scaffold
- Installing an overhead gantry on Swanston Street, adjacent to the La Trobe Street site using a crane, elevated work platform, and hand tools
- Backfilling the shaft using a concrete pump, concrete trucks, light towers, a crane, an elevated work platform, small drill rig and hand tools.



Indicative only

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- Backfilling works involve increased truck movements. Concrete trucks will enter the site from La Trobe Street and are required to reverse up to the concrete pump which will be located adjacent to the shaft
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times
- The footpath on Swanston Street (adjacent to the La Trobe Street site) will be closed during the gantry installation works. Access will be maintained via the eastern side of Swanston Street
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists and motorists around the work area.

When

- Backfilling will take place from **6pm to 6am, Monday to Fridays, from Tuesday 3 December until Friday 20 December**
- Oversized deliveries to demobilise the scrubber (ventilation system) components from the temporary shaft will take place from **1am to 5am, between Tuesday 26 November and Friday 29 November**
- Gantry delivery and installation will take place from **8pm to 6am between Monday 25 November and Friday 29 November.**
